

Acknowledging Sources

1. Re-use of material copied by/from Isle of Man Public Record Office.

Under sections 29, 43 and 49 of the Copyright Right Act 1991, recipients of copies of documents or maps from the Isle of Man Public Record Office are not permitted to re-use copies in any of the following ways, without written permission from the Public Records Officer or relevant Government officer:

- Posting copies on websites and online forums
- Filming copies for television
- Email of copies to other parties
- Exhibition of copies
- Publication of copies in books, leaflets, magazines etc.

Written consent should always be obtained before re-use of copies and a complimentary copy of the work presented to the Isle of Man Public Record Office for public use. Please note that a reproduction fee may be charged for commercial publications, details of which are available on request: public.records@gov.im
