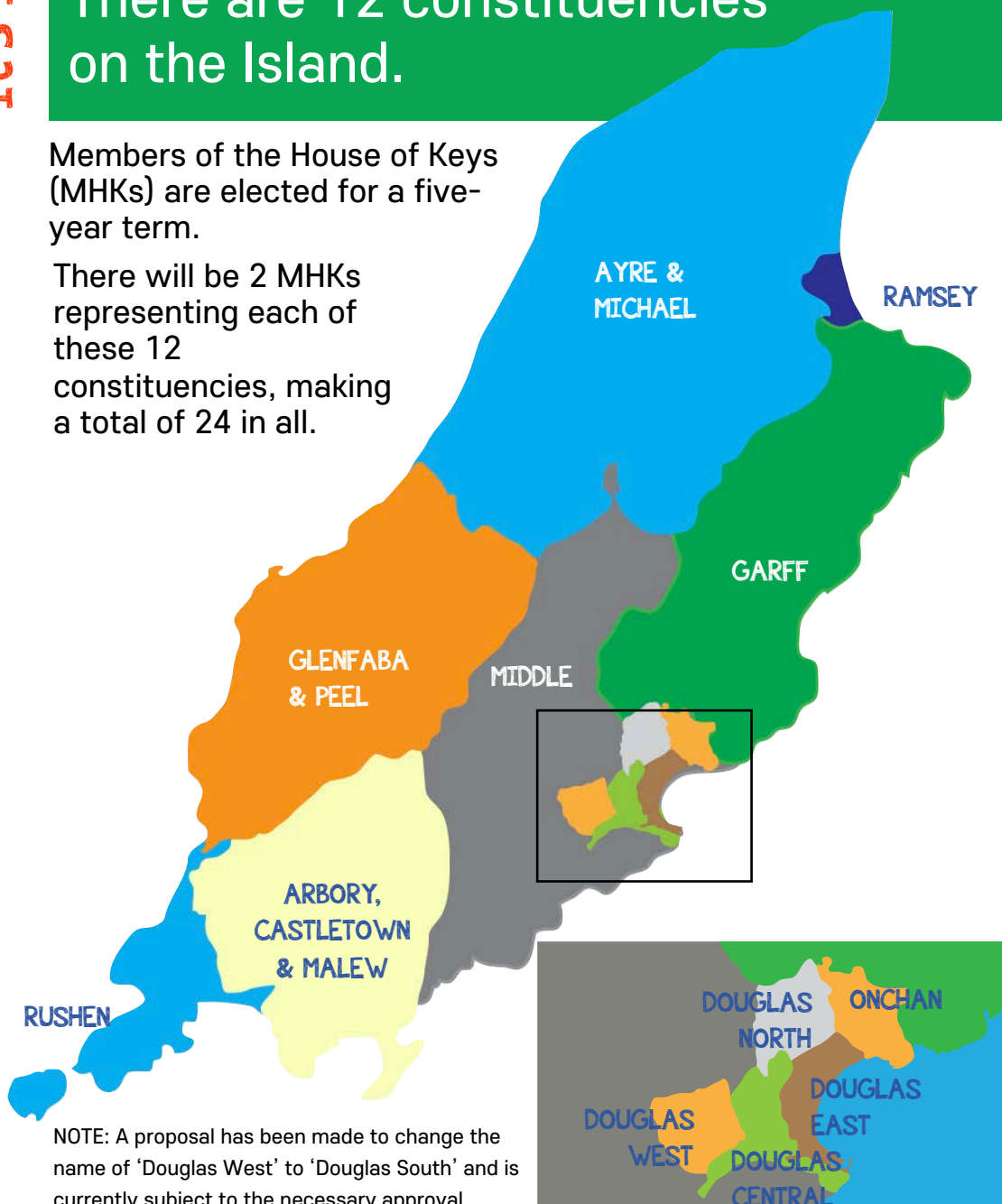
The Isle of Man is one of only a few places around the world where you can vote at 16 – Don't miss out on your chance to shape the Island's future!

WHICH HOUSE OF KEYS CONSTITUENCY ARE YOU?

There are 12 constituencies
on the Island.

Members of the House of Keys (MHKs) are elected for a five-year term.

There will be 2 MHKs representing each of these 12 constituencies, making a total of 24 in all.

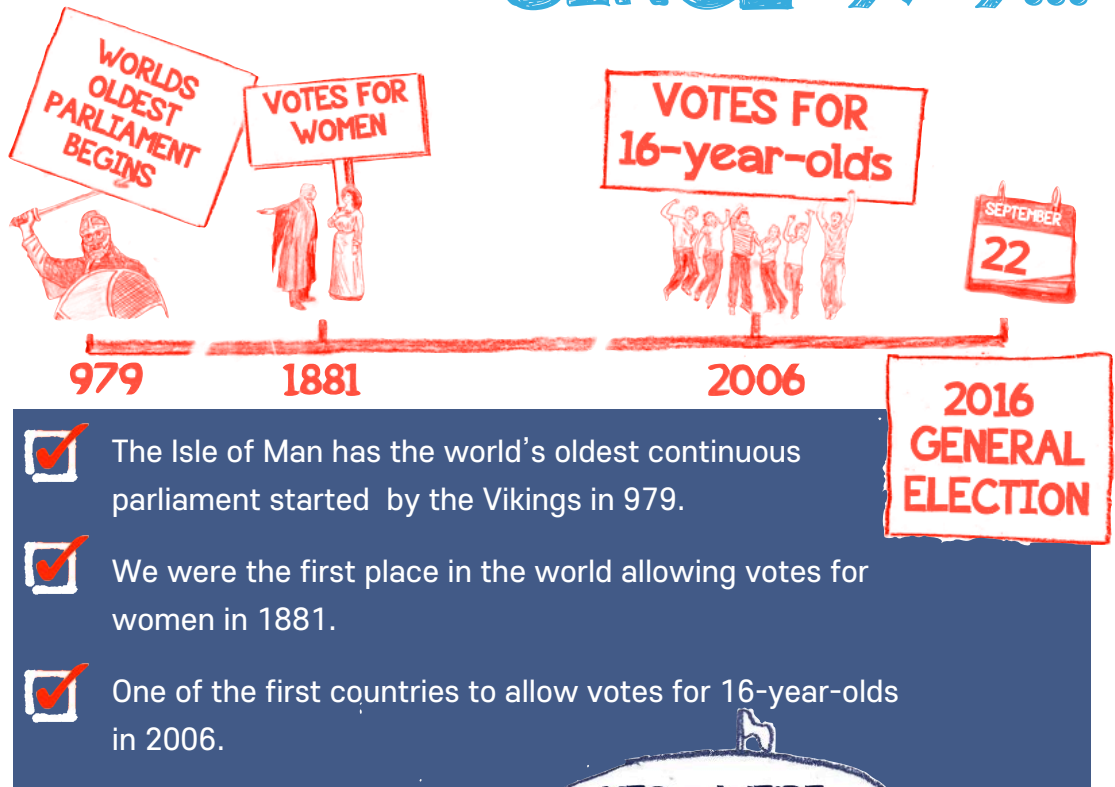

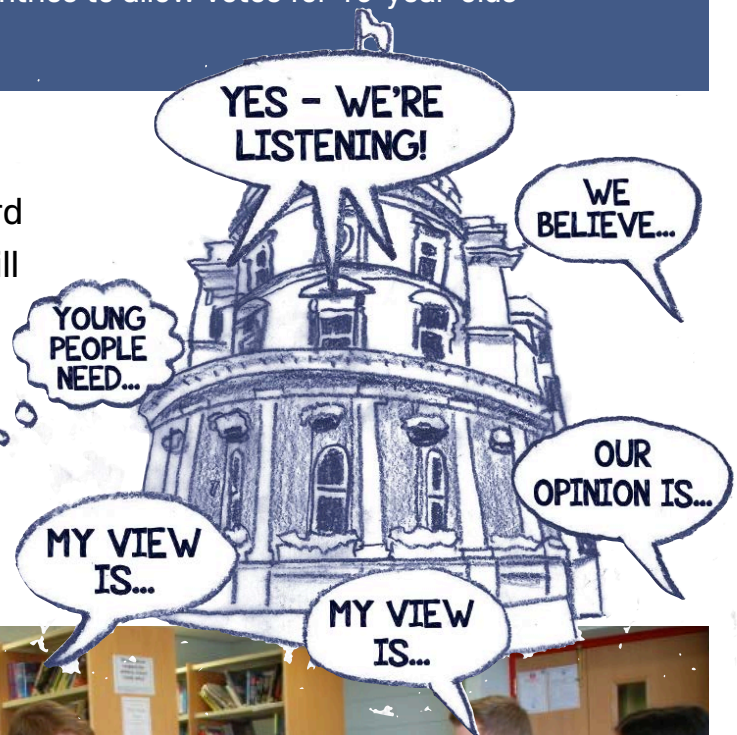

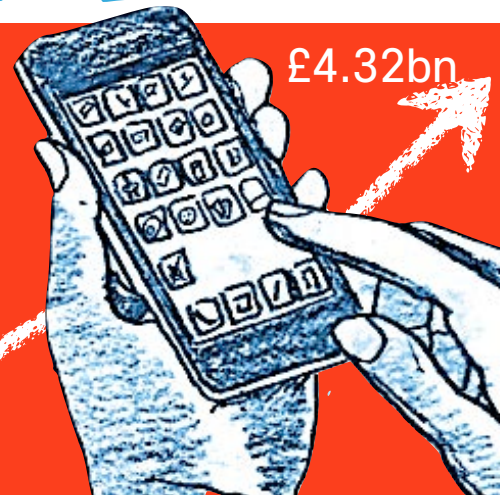


VOTING is the way to make YOUR voice heard and to choose WHO will best represent the interests of young people on the Island.



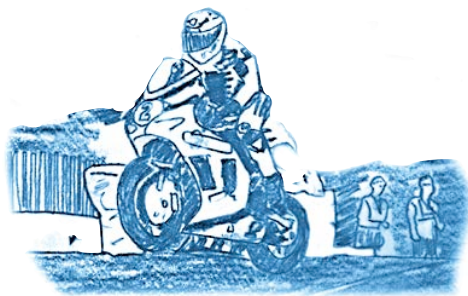
MAKING THE ISLAND GREAT!

The Island's economic power has been on the rise for a number of years.



In 2014 GDP stood at £4.32 bn with e-gaming replacing Insurance as the largest economic sector on the Isle of Man, with a 16.7% share of Manx-Sourced Income.

The Island's tourism and sporting achievements have also enjoyed huge boosts with the ever growing TT experience putting the Island on the world stage.



The Island has recently been recognised as one of the best places in the world to explore. UNESCO has designated the Island a 'Biosphere reserve' saying it's a special place for people and nature'.
