

AIR NAVIGATION (ISLE OF MAN) ORDER 2015

VALIDATION OF AIR TRAFFIC CONTROLLER AND STUDENT AIR TRAFFIC CONTROLLER LICENCES AND MEDICAL CERTIFICATES

Exemption 08/2020

- 1. The Department for Enterprise ("the Department"), in exercise of its powers under Article 156 of the Air Navigation (Isle of Man) Order 2015¹ ("the 2015 Order") exempts the holder of an air traffic controller or student air traffic controller licence from the requirement to submit an application to have a license, rating, endorsement, or medical certificate validated by the Department as specified in Article 122(1) of the 2015 Order.
- 2. This exemption is granted subject to the air traffic controller's or student air traffic controller's licence and medical certificate being issued by the United Kingdom Civil Aviation Authority in accordance with Commission Regulation (EU) 2015/340 and its transitional provisions².
- **3.** Licences and medical certificates referred to in paragraph 2 are automatically rendered as being validated by the Department for the purposes of Article 144 of the 2015 Order without the need for the Department to issue a certificate of validation as required by Articles 122(2) and (3) of the 2015 Order.
- **4.** This exemption shall have effect from the 1 January 2020 until 31 December 2021, unless previously revoked, varied or suspended.
