(AH) advised the Commissioners that the removal of the bollards at the clock tower Foxdale was on schedule.

The Commissioners also advised they had spoken to Jim Davidson (DOI) with regard to Mines Road Junction and a meeting was set up for 27 June 2016.

It was also there would be no traffic calming with the new resurfacing, (RG) MPU reported had carried out speed counts and there was no evidence of speeding traffic.

|  | <p><b>Scheme Status Report</b></p> <p>AH (DOI) provided an update of the Scheme Status Report (SSR), informing the meeting that priority would be given to those schemes with related road safety issues over amenity ones.</p> <p><b><u>New Traffic Management Scheme Requests</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Patrick Commissioners</u></b></p> <p>A request from Patrick Commissioners for speed limits on Archalligan Terrace and Springfield Rise. AH advised it would go on the SSR for assessment.</p> <p>(JG) also raised the Commissioners concerns with regard to visibility and parking when exiting the petrol station in Foxdale and requested temerary bollards be installed until the Foxdale Road improvement scheme commences.</p> <p>There was also a request from the Commissioners for dropped kerbs on Springfield Terrace and Mines Road Foxdale.</p> <p><b><u>German</u></b></p> <p>(PD) requested a reason why Highway improvement requests from German Parish Commissioners had NFA e.g. why their request for a mini roundabout at Tynwald Hill crossroads was rejected following a RTA, (RG) MPU advised that no accidents had been reported at this junction and the incident (PD) referred to was the fault of the scooter rider.</p> <p>The Commissioners also requested the TT bus stop on the Foxdale Road St Johns be moved away from the bend where it would be safer.</p> <p>The Commissioners also requested SID signs for St Johns (AH) to review.</p> <p><b><u>Peel</u></b></p> <p>(DS) Peel Town Commissioners requested Tim Cowin (HAM) set up a meeting to discuss the Traffic Management Plan with car parking the main issue</p> <p>(DS) also reported the coach parking request had not progressed, (AH) advised this was linked to the Peel Regeneration scheme,</p> <p>(DS) also requested feedback on all Highway schemes.</p> | <p><b>AH</b></p> <p><b>AH</b></p> |
