

### THE ROAD TRANSPORT ACT 2001

## The Public Passenger Vehicles (Visiting Drivers) (Exemption) Regulations 2006

Approved by Tynwald	22 June 2006
Coming into operation	1st July 2006

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by sections 40(1) and 62(1) of the Road Transport Act  $2001^1$ , and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Road Transport Licensing Committee and such representative bodies as the Department thinks fit, the following Regulations are hereby made:-

## 1. Citation, commencement, and revocation

(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Public Passenger Vehicles (Visiting Drivers) (Exemption) Regulations 2006 and, subject to section 62(6) of the Road Transport Act 2001, shall come into operation on 1st July 2006.

(2) The Road Transport (Driver Licensing) (Exemption) Regulations 2002<sup>2</sup> are hereby revoked.

# 2. Disapplication of section 40(1) of the Road Transport Act 2001


Save as provided in articles 6 and 9 of the Road Vehicles (International Circulation) Order  $2006^3$ , section 40(1) of the Road Transport Act 2001 shall not apply to a person to whom article 5 or 7 of that Order applies.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE (This Note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations replace the Road Transport (Driver Licensing) (Exemption) Regulations 2002. They exempt visiting drivers of public passenger vehicles from being licensed under section 40(1) of the Road Transport Act 2001 in cases where they are not required to be so licensed under the Road Vehicles (International Circulation) Order 2006.
