# REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS AND DEATHS (FEES) REGULATIONS 2016

Approved by Tynwald:

21 July 2016

Coming into Operation:

22 July 2016

The Treasury makes the following Regulations under sections 15(1), 16(1) and (2), 26(3) and (5), 35(2), 36(1) and (3), 37(1) and 43(2) of the Civil Registration Act 1984.

#### 1 Title

These Regulations are the Registration of Births and Deaths (Fees) Regulations 2016.

#### 2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald, these Regulations come into operation on 22 July 2016.<sup>1</sup>

#### 3 Fees

- (1) In this article
  - (a) "the table" means the table set out in the Schedule; and
  - (b) a reference to a numbered column is a reference to the column of the table so numbered.
- (2) In the table—
  - (a) column 1 specifies the relevant sections of legislation under which a matter arises for which a fee is payable;
  - (b) column 2 specifies the matter in respect of which a fee is payable; and
  - (c) column 3 specifies the fee payable in respect of the matter.

#### 4 Revocation

The Registration of Births and Deaths (Fees) Regulations 2013<sup>2</sup> are revoked.
