
THE IMMIGRATION (VARIATION OF LEAVE) (NO. 2) ORDER 1991

Made 30th July, 1991.
Coming into force on 1st August 1991

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Lieutenant Governor by sections 3(3) and 4(1) of the Immigration Act 1971(a) (on Act of Parliament), as extended to the Isle of Man by the Immigration (Isle of Man) Order 1972 (b) an Order in Council, and all other Powers enabling him in that behalf, the following Order is hereby made:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Variation of Leave) (No.2) Order 1991 and shall come into force on
2. The condition imposed by article 2 of the Immigration (Variation of Leave) Order 1991 (c) is hereby removed.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order removes the condition imposed by the Immigration (Variation of leave) Order 1991 which requires all Iraqi nationals who are not also British citizens or persons exercising an enforceable Community right or rights under and provision made under section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 and who have a limited leave to enter or remain in the Isle of Man, to register with the police as a condition of that leave if such a requirement is not already such a condition.
