Description of series: The series comprises 13 minute books and 1 folder which furnish an account of the meetings of the Forestry, Mines and Lands Board's committee. In effect, the series documents the day-to-day decision making processes of the board as well as the activities undertaken by the board in order to realise its statutory functions as laid down by the Forestry, Mines and Lands Act, 1950.

The act was signed by the Lieutenant Governor, G R Bromet, on the 23 Jun 1950 and came into operation 11 Jul 1950. The earliest minuted meeting extant in the series, the 18 May 1950, occurs just over a month prior to the Lieutenant Governor's assent being given to the act and runs through until the dissolution of the board in 1986.

Activities detailed in the minutes include but are not limited to: the election of board members; the appointment of the board's Secretary and Clerk; the appointment of Inspectors; the undertaking of surveys and the issuing of reports regarding the management of the board's assets; the lease, sale and purchase of land; and the general day-to-day management of forestry and mineral assets held by the board on the island.

Administrative History: In 1947, Tynwald agreed to purchase all Crown property on the Island including common lands, minerals, quarries, forests, foreshores and territorial sea.

The new board drawing its name from the legislation which established it - The Forestry, Mines and Lands Act, 1950 - took on the responsibility for the management of a number of the aforementioned assets, namely: forestry, minerals and lands.

The board's land management function was transferred from the Common Lands Board; while its forestry management function was transferred from the Board of Agriculture and Fisheries. The Board ceased to exist in 1986 when its core functions were in turn transferred to the newly created Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry (DAFF).

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Custodial History: Records in consignment C630 were transferred to the Isle of Man Public Record Office as a temporary consignment under section 3(8) of the Public Records Act in Mar 2010 by the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry (Forestry, Amenity and Lands division). The records were fully transferred to the Isle of Man Public Record Office under section 3(4) of the Public Records Act 1999 in Jan 2016.

Decision making processes and activities evidenced by the series include but are not limited to the following topics: estate and land management; forestry management; boundary maintenance and boundary disputes; and the lease and rental administration of the board's forestry, mineral and land assets.

Creator: Isle of Man; Forestry, Mines and Lands Board; circa 1950-1986

Description of series:

The series comprises 3 volumes which furnish a granular account of the day-to-day management of the forests and woodlands controlled by the Forestry, Mines and Lands Board.

For the purposes of effective management, the board's forest and woodland assets were divided into administrative compartments and sub-compartments with crop rotations generally being affected every 30 years. 5 form types were produced in order to stream-line the administration of compartments throughout the forestry life-cycle of pre-thinning, thinning and maturation.

Form 1 furnishes the following information: the land parcel's name, the compartment number, the date of first registration, the acreage, the species planted, remarks and any treatments undertaken. Form 2 provides a work log of activities undertaken at the board's instruction in order to ensure the proper management of forest and woodland assets. Form 3 details ingoing and outgoing monies associated with the management of the compartments. Form 4 serves as a 'Nursery' record documenting the transplantation of saplings affected during the general forestry stock take which occurred annually each August. Form 5 was utilised to detail the appreciation in value of compartments over the course of their life-cycle.
