Introduction

The Crisis Response Home Treatment Team (CRHTT) is a service set up to respond to and support adults who are experiencing an acute mental health problem which could lead to an inpatient admission to a psychiatric hospital.

The main aim of the CRHTT is to help you manage and resolve your crisis through assessment and treatment in the home environment as an alternative to hospital admission. We also support people being discharged from the Inpatient Ward and enabling recovery to continue at home.

What we offer:

We will work closely with you, your family/carers and your social networks to provide intensive support and care, helping you to draw on your own strengths and assist in developing different ways of improving and maintaining your mental health. We will also help you access other services that could be relevant to your care.

Whilst under our care you will have access to the team between 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Our input will be short term, intensive and is flexible to your individual needs in order to help resolve your current difficulties at the earliest time.

Who will you see?

The team is made up of Mental Health Professionals such as a Psychiatric, Psychiatric Nurses and support workers, all of whom may work with you to resolve your current crisis. If applicable your current Care Co-ordinator and the Community Mental Health Team will also stay actively involved in your care.

The team will discuss with any longer term support needs and will make referrals to the appropriate service as required.

Early discharge: from the inpatient service

If you need to be admitted to Hospital our aim is to help you return home as soon as possible. The aim is therefore for the CRHTT to consider with you and your carers whether early discharge with intensive home treatment could be the right thing for you.

When this Service is available:

The CRHTT operates 7 days a week 24 hours a day.

This service is also available by phoning the CRHTT out of hours on **642860**

Your Information:

CRHTT record information in accordance with the Data Protection Act 2002. All your information is stored securely. We only share information with the MDT on a strict need to know basis.

On occasions we may have a duty to share information where there is a need to protect public safety, safety of patients or others.

Complaints:

If you are unhappy about the service provided we will attempt to resolve your concerns as quickly and as informally as possible.
