

To: The Hon Clare Christian MLC, President of Tynwald and the Honourable Council and Keys in Tynwald assembled.


In November 2007 Tynwald resolved that the Council of Ministers consider the establishment of a suitable body for the preservation of War Memorials in the Isle of Man.

Introduction

At the Tynwald sitting in October 2008 approval was given to the establishment of a Body for the Preservation of the Island's War Memorials to be called the Isle of Man Government Preservation of War Memorials Committee ('the Committee').

The Committee is responsible for -

- (a) ensuring a proper registration of War Memorials throughout the Isle of Man;
- (b) encouraging the proper maintenance and upkeep of such memorials; and
- (c) avoiding the destruction of, or overseeing the removal of, such memorials by encouraging the owners or custodians to advise the Committee that such is likely prior to such actions being taken so as to enable the Committee to ascertain any actions that may be appropriate for them to safeguard the memorial.

The establishment of the Committee did not remove the responsibility for War Memorials from Local Authorities.

The Committee is required to produce an Annual Report to be published and made available on the Government Website.

The tenure of the membership of the Committee is at the pleasure of the Council of Ministers and by appointment following every General Election. The current membership is made up as follows:-

Meetings of the Committee for year ending June 2016

Summary

(a) Meetings

During the year ending June 2016 the Committee met on 6 occasions.

- (b) Membership changes during the year
 - The Venerable Andrew Brown Archdeacon of Man, Mr Robert Dowty and Rev Ian Faulds were welcomed to the Committee;
 - the Committee was delighted to congratulate Mr Hector Duff TH MM BEM on receiving the Honorary Freedom of the Borough of Douglas; and
 - the Committee wishes to place on record its best wishes to Mrs Fiona
 Robinson in her new role. Mrs Robinson stood down as a member this year
 and we wish to express our appreciation for her contribution to the work of
 the Committee;
- (c) The War Memorials Act 2016

The War Memorials Act 2016 received Royal Assent at the April 2016 sitting of Tynwald and provides for the creation of a War Memorials Register. The Act also provides statutory protection to war memorials. Please see at page 11 under **Appendix 1** a copy of the Act.

(d) Register of Isle of Man War Memorials

The Committee has continued its work creating a register of War Memorials to ensure they are recognised and cared for in the future, the register details the War Memorials throughout the Isle of Man and includes the following information—

- location;
- brief description;
- a record of photographs showing the War Memorial and its location;
- (where known) the War, campaign, action or unit commemorated;
- the date the memorial was erected and/or dedication;
- transcript of inscriptions and names so that a permanent record exists in case of future damage or loss; and
- (where known) the designer/maker/craftsperson who created the War Memorial.

The register is then maintained by Manx National Heritage ('MNH') and is available on its digital research facility via www.imuseum.im.

Please see below the table, which is an extract taken from the register of War Memorials, and lists the locations, types of memorial and the responsibility at page 17 under **Appendix 2**.

MNH also holds a record of the grid reference, condition reports, historic information and digital mapping. The data is being used for online visitors, teacher training, family history workshops, shared with War Memorials Trust; Historypin and other online partners.

I would encourage anyone with an interest in Manx War Memorials to visit www.imuseum.im.

(e) Committee visits

Throughout the year the lay members continued a programme of visits and made contact with various custodians around the Island to advise on, and encourage, proper maintenance and care of the Island's memorials.

(f) Malew Parish War Memorial

Members of the Committee attended a meeting with Malew Parish Commissioners to discuss the proposals for the Parish War Memorial, over which there are significant concerns. The Committee has been advised that the work on the repair of the memorial is expected to commence shortly.

(g) All Saints Church Lonan - memorials

The Committee received assurance that the memorials within Lonan Church fall under the Church of England's faculty and are therefore protected. A book of remembrance has been transferred from All Saints Church and is now on display in Christ Church Laxey.

(h) Regent Street Post Office - memorials

In relation to the future of the Regent Street Post Office building, the Post Office has acknowledged the importance of the two memorial plaques within the building and gave assurance that there would be consultation with the appropriate parties over any relocation arrangement.

(i) Douglas Crematorium - memorial

The Committee wishes to congratulate Douglas Borough Council for the work undertaken to both enhance and preserve the War Memorial at the Crematorium.

Way Forward

The Committee will continue its work to ensure that the remit determined following the Tynwald Resolution is fulfilled and to seek the support of custodians to maintain their memorials in good order.

The Committee will continue to build on the close working relationship with MNH, as there is a mutual benefit from working together to establish a single register which will meet the requirements of both bodies.

The Committee works closely with the Church Authority and is delighted that the Venerable Andrew Brown, Archdeacon of Man, is part of the Committee membership.

The War Memorial Act 2016 received Royal Assent at the April 2016 sitting of Tynwald and work is already underway with the legislative drafter to provide the secondary legislation required to bring this Bill into force.

Photographic record

The Committee continues to establish a photographic record of the Isle of Man War Memorials; please see below two selected examples taken from our record:

St John's War Memorial

The inscription reads: The names of the 1261 men are listed from every parish of the Island who gave their lives during the First World War (1914–1918) and of the 494 men from every parish of the Island who gave their lives during the Second World War (1939–1945).



Marown Parish War Memorial

The inscription reads: To the glory of God and in proud remembrance of these men of the parish of Marown who gave their lives in the Great War.

14 names listed from First World War and 3 names listed from the Second World War.

AN ACT to make fresh provision about war memorials; and for connected purposes.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Council and Keys in Tynwald assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 Short title

The short title of this Act is the War Memorials Act 2016.

2 Commencement

- (1) This Act comes into operation on such day or days as the Council of Ministers may by order appoint.
- (2) An order under subsection (1) may make such consequential, incidental, supplemental, transitional and transitory provision as appears to the Council of Ministers to be necessary or expedient.

3 Interpretation

In this Act-

"the Department" means the Department of Environment, Food and Agriculture;

"registered war memorial" means a war memorial entered in the War Memorials

Register; and

"war memorial" means, subject to section 5(6), any property (whether real or personal) which has as its purpose the permanent physical and public commemoration of service or sacrifice in or in connection with war or other armed conflict, other than —

(a) a grave, a grave marker or a tombstone; or

(b) a memorial to a single individual or individuals all of whom were members of the same family;

"War Memorial Committee" means a body established (before or after the commencement of this Act) for the purpose of creating a war memorial; "War Memorials Register" means the register maintained under section 4.

4 War Memorials Register

The Council of Ministers must cause to be maintained and published, in such form and manner as the Council of Ministers may determine, a register of war memorials in the Island ("the War Memorials Register").

5 Creation of war memorials and designation of property as a war memorial

- (1) The Council of Ministers may consent to the creation of a war memorial.
- (2) No person may create a war memorial without such consent.
- (3) Where consent has been given under subsection (1), the war memorial which the consent authorises may be created without the need for any other consent, licence or permission of any kind.
- (4) Upon the completion of a war memorial created with the consent of the Council of Ministers under subsection (1) the Council of Ministers must cause the war memorial to be entered in the War Memorials Register.
- (5) A consent under subsection (1)—
 - (a) must be given in writing;
 - (b) must specify the nature and form of the war memorial which it authorises; and
 - (c) without limiting paragraph (b), may impose, or authorise the imposition by the Department, of such conditions, requirements or restrictions on the consent as appear to the Council of Ministers to be necessary or appropriate.
- (6) If it appears to the Council of Ministers that it is in the national interest that any real or personal property, which would be a war memorial but for the exception in paragraph (a) or (b) of the definition of that term, should be designated as a war memorial, the Council of Ministers may —
 - (a) designate the property as a war memorial; and
 - (b) cause that war memorial to be entered in the War Memorials Register.
- (7) Before designating property as a war memorial in accordance with subsection(6) the Council of Ministers must consult—
 - (a) the local authority within whose area the item is situate; and

- (b) any person appearing to the Council of Ministers to have an interest in the item or in the proposal to designate the item under subsection (6).
- (8) The Council of Ministers must make rules about the procedure for
 - (a) an application for consent under subsection (1); and
 - (b) the designation of property as a war memorial under subsection (6).
- (9) Rules under subsection (8) must be laid before Tynwald as soon as reasonably practicable after they are made.

6 Ownership and maintenance of war memorials

- (1) The owner of a registered war memorial must maintain it.
- (2) If, after reasonable enquiry
 - (a) the ownership of a registered war memorial cannot be determined, or
 - (b) the owner of a registered war memorial cannot be found, the Council of Ministers may make a declaration under subsection (3).
- (3) A declaration under this subsection may provide that the registered war memorial
 - (a) is the property of the owner of the land comprised in it or upon which it stands; or
 - (b) is to vest in the local authority within whose area it is for the time being situate.

7 Vesting of registered war memorials in local authority

- (1) The owner of a registered war memorial may apply to the Council of Ministers to vest it in a local authority.
- (2) If satisfied that it is in the public interest to do so, on an application under subsection (1) the Council of Ministers may vest the registered war memorial in the local authority within whose area it is for the time being situate.
- (3) Before exercising the power conferred by subsection (2), if it is practicable to do so, the Council of Ministers must consult the owner of the registered war memorial.
- (4) On vesting the local authority becomes the owner of the registered war memorial, and accordingly section 6(1) applies to the authority.

8 Powers of local authorities

(1) A local authority may —

- (a) insure any registered war memorial vested in the authority;
- (b) expend monies on the maintenance of a registered war memorial (whether or not vested in the authority and wherever it is located on the Island);
- (c) with the consent of the Department, borrow money for the purposes of the authority's functions under this Act;
- (d) accept monies from a War Memorial Committee, or an officer of such a Committee for the purpose of maintaining a registered war memorial.
- (2) In this section "maintenance" includes alteration, extension, inscription, protection, relocation, renewal or repair.

9 Application of provisions of Parts 3 to 5 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1999 to registered war memorials

- (1) The Council of Ministers may by order apply Parts 3 to 5 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1999 to war memorials.
- (2) An order under subsection (1) may
 - (a) make such modifications of those Parts, and
 - (b) include such consequential, incidental or supplemental provisions,as appears to the Council of Ministers to be appropriate.
- (3) An order under subsection (1) must not come into operation unless approved by Tynwald.

10 Exceptions for ecclesiastical jurisdiction

- (1) The Council of Ministers may by order disapply or modify sections 5 to 9 (and enactment applied under section 9) in relation to a registered war memorial which
 - (a) is attached to,
 - (b) forms part of, or
 - (c) is situate within the curtilage of,
 - a church building which is for the time being used for ecclesiastical purposes and which is subject to appropriate ecclesiastical control.
- (2) For the purposes of subsection (1) "appropriate ecclesiastical control" and "ecclesiastical purposes" have such meaning as the order under that subsection provides.
- (3) An order under subsection (1) must not come into operation unless approved by Tynwald.

11 Repeal

The War Memorials (Local Authorities' Powers) Act 1927 is repealed.
