



## AIR NAVIGATION (ISLE OF MAN) ORDER 2015

### LICENSING OF AIR TRAFFIC CONTROLLERS

#### Exemption 09/2020

1. The Department for Enterprise ("the Department"), in exercise of its powers under Article 156 of the Air Navigation (Isle of Man) Order 2015<sup>1</sup> ("the 2015 Order") exempts the holder of an air traffic controller or student air traffic controller licence issued by the United Kingdom Civil Aviation Authority in accordance with Commission Regulation (EU) 2015/340 from the following Articles and their requirements:
  - a. Article 111 - Language proficiency: additional requirements.
  - b. Article 112 - Language proficiency: ongoing requirements.
  - c. Article 113 - Privileges of an air traffic controller's licence and a student air traffic controller's licence.
  - d. Article 114 - Maintenance of validity of ratings and endorsements.
  - e. Article 115 - Obligation to notify rating ceasing to be valid and change of unit.
  - f. Article 116 - Air navigation service provider: maintenance of records.
  - g. Article 117 - Requirement for medical certificate.
  - h. Article 118 - Incapacity of air traffic controllers.
2. This exemption shall have effect from the 1 January 2020 until 31 December 2021, unless revoked, varied or suspended.

2. The EU requirements on the holder of an air traffic controller or student air traffic controller licence issued in accordance with Commission Regulation (EU) 2015/340 achieve an equivalent level of safety with the exempted Articles.
