



TT Practice & Race Weeks 2018 Service Revisions



Details of bus service alterations during road closures for the TT Practices and Races are shown below.

Evening Practice: Saturday 26th May and Monday 28th May to Friday 1st June 2018
Roads closed between **1800** to no later than **2130**.

Race Days: Saturday 2nd June - Roads closed from **1100** until racing is finished (no later than **2130**).
Monday 4th and Wednesday 6th June - Roads closed from **1000** until racing is finished (no later than **2130**).
Friday 8th June - Roads closed from **0930** until racing is finished (no later than **2130**).

Days of Operation

Please note the following days of operation during the TT period:

On Monday 28th May the Bank Holiday service operates.

On Tuesday 29th May, Wednesday 30th May & Thursday 31st May the schoolday (Sch) service operates.

On Friday 1st and 4th to 7th June the school holiday (NSch) service operates.

On Sunday 3rd June and Friday 8th June the Bank Holiday service operates with extra journeys on some services to serve TT activities.

Please note the enhanced Service 5/6/6A timetable which operates daily from Wednesday 30th May to Saturday 9th June (inclusive)

The Saturday service operates on 26th May, 2th June & 9th June.

The normal Sunday service operates on 27th May and 10th June.

Wildlife Park

Buses do not serve the bus stop in the Wildlife Park from Monday 21st May to Tuesday 12th June. Buses toward Ramsey stop at the car park entrance. There is NO stop for buses travelling towards Peel and Douglas.

Peel Promenade

Due to additional traffic during the T.T. period buses do not serve the Peel Quayside and Promenade stops between Saturday 26th May and Sunday 10th June (inclusive).

On 26th, 27th, 28th & 29th May and 10th June Service 5/5C/6/6A journeys operate from Tynwald Road via Albany Road to the Peel Town Hall stop. Service 5 journeys then depart at the normal time to Ballawattleworth. Service 6/6A journeys depart at the Promenade time to Peveril Road and Ballawattleworth. During the period 30th May to 9th June the enhanced Service 5/6/6A timetable operates with resultant route variation.

Sea Terminal Bus Stop

To accommodate the entertainment tent, the Loch Promenade bus stop at the Sea Terminal is suspended from Friday 25th May until Sunday 10th June (inclusive).

Departures from Banks Circus, Douglas

During busy periods scheduled departures from Banks Circus may not be possible. Anyone who normally boards their bus at Banks Circus is advised to travel to either Lord Street or Loch Promenade by any departure from Banks Circus.

Ramsey Departure Points

On practice nights buses depart from the Christian Street/Albert Road junction (opposite the Bus Station).
On TT Race Days, during the TT course closure period the departure point for bus services which start in Ramsey is beside the bowling hall on Queens Promenade.

Service 1/2/10/11/12/12A

Evening Practice Nights:-

- Service 1 to Hailwood Avenue operates as timetabled to Hillberry Road then via Birch Hill (to turn) and as timetabled from Avondale Road.
- Service 2A operates to Ballachrink as timetabled.
- Service 11 operates to Birch Hill as timetabled - returning to Douglas as the Service 12 at 06 minutes past each hour.
- Service 12 via Bucks Road is replaced between Lord Street and St Ninians by Service 22V.
The departures from Birch Hill at 06 minutes past each hour still operate with connections at Lord Street for journeys to Ronaldsway Airport, Castletown and Port Erin.

Daytime Race Days:-

- Service 1 to and from Birch Hill operates as timetabled.
- Service 1/10 to Hailwood Avenue/Nobles Hospital operates as timetabled to Hillberry Road then via Birch Hill (to turn) and as timetabled from Avondale Road.
- Services 2 and 2A operate to Ballachrink as timetabled.
- If racing is delayed Services 11 & 12 operate as shown for evening practices.
- On 30st & 31st May and 1st, 2nd, 4th, 5th, 6th & 7th June between 1500 and 1820 services arriving in Douglas from Port Erin terminate at Loch Promenade and are replaced by Service 1&2 operating from Loch Promenade at 1505, 1525, 1545, 1605, 1625, 1645, 1705, 1725, 1745 & 1805 as shown below and normal services recommence with the 1825 Service 1 departure from Loch Promenade.
- The Service 10 Loch Promenade arrivals at 1541 and 1641 operate via Broadway and Victoria Road to Hailwood Avenue, Watterson Lane and Nobles Hospital.
The 1556 & 1656 Service 1 departures from Nobles Hospital operate via Cronkbourne, Hailwood Avenue, Victoria Road and Broadway to Lord Street. The 1721 departure from Nobles Hospital operates via Hillberry Road and Royal Avenue as normal.

Service 3/3A

Evening Practice Nights:-

- The 1745, 1845 (not Sat) & 1945 Service 3 departures from Douglas (Lord Street) divert from Woodbourne Road via York Road, Broadway and Summerhill Road to the Manx Arms.
- The 1815, 1915 & 2015 Service 3A departures from Douglas (Lord Street) divert from Woodbourne Road via Somerset Road, St Ninians, Ballaquayle Road, Broadway and Summerhill Road to the Manx Arms.
- The 1740, 1810 (not Sat), 1840 & 1940 divert from the Manx Arms via Summer Hill and Promenades to Lord Street.

Daytime Race Days:-

- Commencing with the first departure from Douglas (Lord Street) to Ramsey less than 30 minutes before the roads are due to close, buses divert from Woodbourne Road via York Road, Broadway and Summerhill Road to the Manx Arms.
- Commencing with the first departure from Manx Arms to Lower Douglas less than 20 minutes before the roads are due to close, buses divert from Whitebridge Road via Royal Avenue, Port Jack, Derby Castle and the Promenades to Lord Street - therefore not serving the Douglas bound stop in Central Onchan.

Service 4/4C

Daytime Race Days (not Friday 8th):-

- After the 0912 Douglas departure all Service 4 journeys are cancelled between Douglas and Peel until the roads re-open or, if racing delayed, the 1612 journey from Douglas to Niarbyl (Not Sat) and the 1635 journey from Niarbyl to Douglas.
- Service 4 departs Peel to Niarbyl at: 0954, 1154, 1354 & 1554.
- Service 4 departs Niarbyl to Peel at: 1010, 1210, 1410 & 1625.
- Service 4C journeys operate as normal between Douglas and Castletown via Higher Foxdale.

Service 5/5A/5C/6/6C

Evening Practice and Daytime Race Days:-

- Commencing with the first departure from Douglas (Lord Street) to Peel less than 30 minutes before the roads are due to close, buses divert from Douglas via Foxdale to St Johns and Peel until the roads re-open.
- Commencing with the first departure from Peel to Douglas less than 30 minutes before the roads are due to close, buses divert from St Johns via Foxdale to Douglas until the roads re-open.
- Service 5 journeys between 30 minutes and 60 minutes of road closure serve Nobles Hospital but DO NOT serve Strang. Service 5 journeys within 30 minutes of road closure DO NOT service Nobles Hospital or Strang.
- Commencing with the first departure from either Peel to Ramsey or Ramsey to Peel less than 35 minutes before the roads are due to close all services are cancelled until the roads re-open.

Service 10, 21A, 26M - Ballaughton Manor Hill

Evening Practice Nights:-

- The 1737 **Service 26M** departure from Lord Street operates via Ballabroogie to Ballaughton Manor Hill ONLY - then diverts from Vicarage Road via Cooil Road and White Hoe to Douglas.

Saturday Race Day:-

- During the period 1030 to 1730 **Service 21A** journeys do not serve Saddle Road and divert from the Meadow Crescent roundabout via Meadow Crescent and Harcroft Avenue to Ballaughton Manor Hill.

Monday and Wednesday Race Days:-

- After the 0911 **Service 10** departure from Nobles Hospital all journeys via Ballaughton and the IOM Business Park are cancelled until the roads re-open.
- Commencing with the 0927 departure from Lord Street **Service 10** journeys via the IOM Business Park to Ballaughton operate as timetabled - then via Stevenson Way, Annacur Road and Groves Road to Lower Douglas.

Service 21H

Evening Practice Nights and Daytime Race Day 8th June:-


- During the closure of the TT Course departures from Lower Douglas operate as far as the Meadow Crescent roundabout - departing from the Heather View stop on Vicarage Road as timetabled.

Service 22/22A/25/26/27

Evening Practice and Daytime Race Days:-

- Commencing with first departures from Douglas (Lord Street) less than 35 minutes before the roads are due to close, **Service 22/22A/25** between Lower Douglas and Willaston are replaced by **Service 22V** which operates via Bucks Road to St Ninians and Victoria Road (Shoprite) - then returning via Bucks Road to Lower Douglas.
- On Evening Practice nights and Race Day Friday 9th June (Bank Holiday timetable operating) when the roads are closed the Service 22V replaces Services 11 & 12 along Woodbourne Road and continues until the roads re-open.
- During TT Course closure periods **Service 26B** operates to and from Ballabroogie only departing Lord Street (stop D) at 0915, 1115, 1315 & 1515 - returning from Ballabroogie at 0926, 1126, 1326 & 1526.
- During TT Course closure periods **Service 27** is suspended.
- A **Service 22L** journey departs from Lord Street (Stop D) 25 minutes before road closure operating via Willaston to Hailwood Avenue. The Service 22L timetable then operates between St Ninians, Willaston, Hailwood Avenue and Nobles Hospital until the roads re-open.
- For full details of Services 22L & 22V please see the timetables below.

Service X3

- **All Journeys:** During the period pm Friday 25th May to Thursday 7th June all **Service X3**  journeys operate via the Coast Road without pick up/set down.
- **Bank Holiday:** On Monday 28th May and Friday 8th June the Bank Holiday bus service operates and therefore no journeys operate.

In the event of delays on Race Days, the pattern of operation for the evening practice nights is followed.

On delayed Race Days when the TT Course re-opens between 1700 and 1800, buses continue to follow the diversion routes with the exception of the journeys below which can safely use the TT Course while it is open to normal traffic.

The 1715 Service 3A departure from Douglas, Lord Street - via Rosemount and Victoria Road.
The 1707 Service 5 (serving the Hospital but not Strang) departure from Douglas, Lord Street - operating to Peel Town Hall and Ballawattleworth only.

The 1722 Service 5A departure from Douglas, Lord Street - operating to Peel Town Hall and Ballawattleworth only.

The 1652 Service 6 and 1715 Service 5 (NOT serving Nobles Hospital or Strang) departures from Peel to Douglas.

The 1650 Service 5 departure from Peel to Ramsey.

The 1730 Service 5C (not via Cronk-y-Voddy) departure from Ramsey to Peel.

The 1657 Service 10 departure from Douglas to the IOM Business Park, Ballaughton and Nobles Hospital - returning via Hailwood Avenue, Hillberry Road, Royal Avenue and the Promenades as timetabled.

The 1714 Service 22A from Lord Street to St Ninians, Willaston (Keppel Road), Hailwood Avenue and Birch Hill - returning to Douglas via Summer Hill and the Promenades.

The 1737 Service 26M departure from Lord Street operates as far as Ballaughton Manor Hill (as per the Evening Practice diversion).

On the days of weekday operation the Service 10 arrivals at Loch Promenade operate immediately via Broadway and Victoria Road to Hailwood Avenue - then as normal via Watterson Lane and Tromode to Nobles Hospital.

The 1556 & 1656 Service I departures from Nobles Hospital operate to Hailwood Avenue as normal, then via Victoria Road and Broadway to Lord Street for the 1635 and 1735 departures to Castletown and Port Erin.

**In the event of racing being postponed to either the evening or the following day
the pattern of service amendments as shown above then operate from the
appropriate time to suit the road closure.**

Additional Information

- All bus users are reminded that during busy times traffic delays can result in buses running later than the times advertised.
Please plan your journey accordingly.
- Road closures may be affected by weather and other influences. When practices or races on the TT Course occur on a date not stated in this booklet then the general pattern of service operated as shown above then apply.
- In the event of the roads re-opening early or a practice/race session being cancelled then services operate/revert to the normal timetable as soon as is practical but it may take up to 1 hour for buses to resume normal service.
