



AIR NAVIGATION (ISLE OF MAN) ORDER 2015
AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHY, AERIAL SURVEY AND AERIAL WORK

Permission 36/2019

1. The Department for Enterprise, pursuant to Article 141 of the Air Navigation (Isle of Man) Order 2015¹, permits:
 - (1) any aircraft to fly over the Isle of Man for the purpose of aerial photography or aerial survey;
 - (2) any aircraft registered in an European Economic Area (EEA) state or Switzerland to fly over the Isle of Man for the purpose of aerial work.
2. This Permission revokes Permission 45/2018 and shall have effect from 02 August 2019 until revoked, varied or suspended.

2. All aerial photography and survey flights within controlled airspace are subject to Non Standard Flight Application – see UK AIP ENR 1.1 and www.nats.co.uk/nsf.
3. Flights shall comply with the Rules of the Air Regulations 2007 (SI 2007/734 amended by SI 2007/1371 and as applied to the Isle of Man).
4. Flights within Isle of Man controlled airspace are subject to ATC clearance.
