From Spool to Douglas

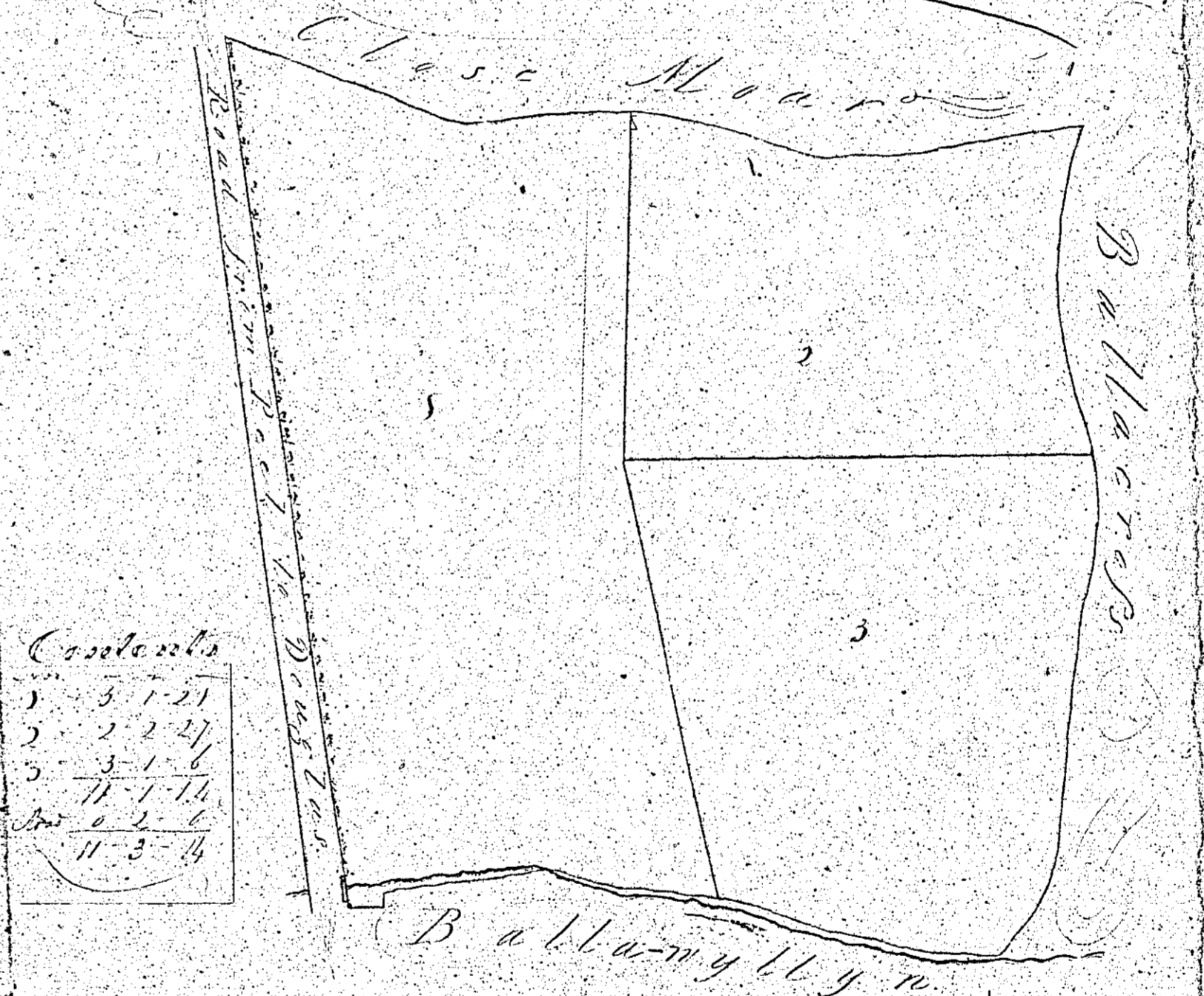
