**Please note: In accordance with the Social Security (Reciprocal Agreement)(Isle of Man) Order 2016 there is now the ability to apply to pay voluntary contributions to improve pension entitlement in one country while paying compulsory contributions to the other country, so building up pension entitlement in both countries. However voluntary contributions cannot be paid to both countries for the same tax year. If voluntary contributions are found to be paid in both the UK and the IOM, the voluntary contributions in one country will be refunded.**
