## MINIMUM WAGE (SINGLE HOURLY RATE) REGULATIONS 2019

*Approved by Tynwald:* 18 June 2019  
*Coming into Operation:* 1 October 2019

The Department for Enterprise and the Treasury, acting jointly, make the following Regulations under section 1(3) of the Minimum Wage Act 2001, after consulting the Minimum Wage Committee in accordance with section 1(4) of that Act and considering the recommendations made by that Committee in accordance with section 2(1) of that Act.

### **1 Title**

These Regulations are the Minimum Wage (Single Hourly Rate) Regulations 2019.

### **2 Commencement**

If approved by Tynwald<sup>1</sup>, these Regulations come into operation on 1 October 2019.

### **3 Interpretation**

In these Regulations “pay reference period” has the meaning given by regulation 10(1) of the Minimum Wage Regulations 2001<sup>2</sup>.

### **4 The single hourly rate**

In relation to any pay reference period beginning on or after 1 October 2019, the single hourly rate is £8.25.

### **5 Revocation**

The Minimum Wage (Single Hourly Rate) Regulations 2018<sup>3</sup> are revoked.

These Regulations increase the single hourly rate of the minimum wage from £7.85 to £8.25 in relation to any pay reference period beginning on or after 1 October 2019.
