GENDER RECOGNITION REGISTER REGULATIONS 2010

Laid before Tynwald: 13 July 2010
Coming into operation: 31 July 2010

The Clerk of the Rolls makes these Regulations under paragraph 2 of Schedule 1 to the Gender Recognition Act 2009¹.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Gender Recognition Register Regulations 2010.

2 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on 31 July 2010.

3 Interpretation

In these Regulations—

“the Act” means the Gender Recognition Act 2009;

“Adopted Children Register” means the register maintained by the Chief Registrar under section 38(1) of the Adoption Act 1984²;

“GRR” means the Gender Recognition Register;

“Manx birth register entry” has the same meaning as in paragraph 2(6) of Schedule 1 to the Act and “birth entry” shall be construed accordingly.

4 Particulars to be entered in the GRR

- (1) Where a Manx birth register entry was made on or before 31 March 1970 and paragraph (4) does not apply, the entry in the GRR shall contain the particulars set out in table 1 in the Schedule.

- (2) Where a Manx birth register entry was made after 31 March 1970 and paragraph (4) does not apply, the entry in the GRR shall contain the particulars set out in table 2 in the Schedule.
- (3) Where a person is the subject of a Manx birth register entry falling within paragraph (1), the entry in the GRR shall include the additional particulars set out in table 3 in the Schedule, if the person who is the subject of the entry requests that they be included.
- (4) Where a Manx birth register entry is contained in the Adopted Children Register, the entry in the GRR shall contain the particulars set out in table 4 in the Schedule.

TABLE 1

Particulars to be entered where the Manx birth register entry was made on or before 31 March 1970

Registration district as recorded in the birth entry
Entry number as recorded in the birth entry
When and where born as recorded in column 1 of the birth entry
Forenames as recorded on the full certificate
Acquired gender as recorded on the full certificate
Name and surname of father as recorded in column 4 of the birth entry
Name and maiden surname of mother as recorded in column 5 of the birth entry
Rank or profession of father as recorded in column 6 of the birth entry
Name, description and residence of informant as recorded in column 7 of the birth entry
When registered as recorded in column 8 of the birth entry
Name of Registrar who signed in column 9 of the birth entry

NHS number as recorded in the birth entry
Registration district as recorded in the birth entry
Entry number as recorded in the birth entry
Date and place of birth as recorded in the birth entry
Forenames and surname as recorded on the full certificate
Acquired gender as recorded on the full certificate
Name and surname of father as recorded in the birth entry
Place of birth of father as recorded in the birth entry
Occupation of father as recorded in the birth entry
Name and surname of mother as recorded in the birth entry
Place of birth of mother as recorded in the birth entry
Maiden surname of mother as recorded in the birth entry
Surname at marriage (if different from maiden surname) of mother as recorded in the birth entry

Qualification of informant as recorded in the birth entry

Additional particulars to be entered (upon request) where the Manx birth register entry was made on or before 31 March 1970

NHS number
Surname as recorded on the full certificate
Place of birth of father
Surname of mother at the time the birth was registered
Place of birth of mother
Surname of mother at marriage (if different from maiden surname)
Usual address of mother (if different from place of child's birth)

TABLE 4

Particulars to be entered where the Manx birth register entry is contained in the Adopted Children Register

Number of entry as recorded in the Adopted Children Register
Date and country of birth of child as recorded in the Adopted Children Register
Forenames and surname as recorded on the full certificate
Acquired gender as recorded on the full certificate
Name and surname, address and occupation of adopter or adopters as recorded in the Adopted Children Register
Date of adoption order and description of court by which made as recorded in the Adopted Children Register or, where there is no court order, the date the adoption is effected and by whom
Date of entry as recorded in the Adopted Children Register
Name of Registrar who signed the Adopted Children Register entry

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations prescribe the particulars that are to be entered in the Gender Recognition Register in relation to a person's birth and other matters. Such an entry will be made by the Chief Registrar where—

- (a) there is a Manx birth register entry in relation to a person to whom a full gender recognition certificate is issued; and
- (b) the documents mentioned in paragraph 2(1)(b) of Schedule 1 to the Gender Recognition Act 2009 are delivered to the Chief Registrar.
