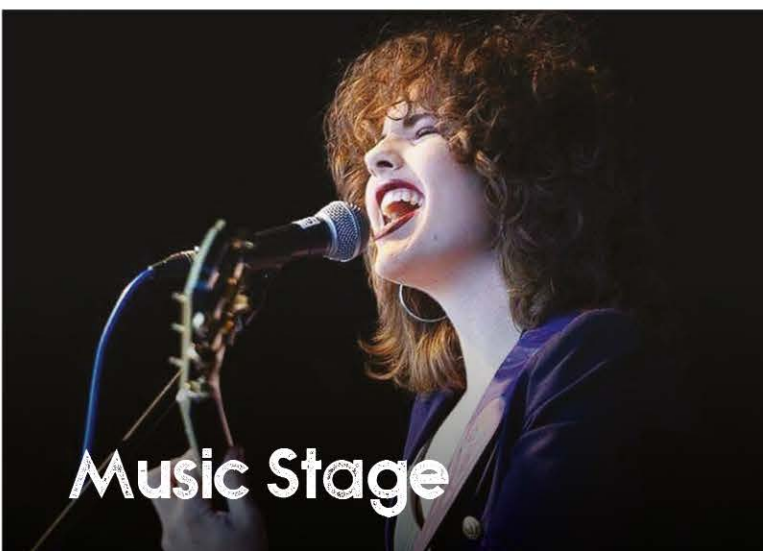

Selasi Gbormittah



Ghanaian Selasi comes from a culture where food plays a huge part in the community. Since competing in The Great British Bake Off he has been involved in commercial branding and events and, most recently, has launched a pop-up bakery through online food delivery company Deliveroo.

A keen biker, he set off on Selasi's Two Wheel Bakery Tour in 2017, visiting bakeries in Belgium, France, Italy, Germany, Spain and Portugal. He is now a professional pastry chef in Switzerland.

Selasi will give two cooking demonstrations in the Manx Food Theatre, judge the Isle of Man Chef of the Year competition, and talk about his journey from amateur to professional baker at 7pm on Saturday night when the festival stays open until 9pm.
