1 Title

This Order is the Immigration (Control of Entry Through Republic of Ireland) (Amendment) Order 2020.

2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation immediately after it is made.

3 Amendment of the Immigration (Control of Entry Through Republic of Ireland) (Amendment) Order 2019

- (1) The Immigration (Control of Entry through Republic of Ireland) (Amendment) Order 2019³ is amended as follows.
- (2) In article 2 for “exit day” substitute **“IP completion day”**⁴.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order amends article 2 of the Immigration (Control of Entry through Republic of Ireland) (Amendment) Order 2019 changing the commencement date to from exit day, to the end of the Implementation Period.
