Description of series: This collection comprises the records of the Isle of Man Court of General Gaol Delivery. The records were created as a result of the Court exercising its function in the judgement of criminal proceedings in both original and appellate jurisdictions. That is, the records which comprise this collection are products of cases first heard in the Court of General Gaol Delivery itself and cases referred to it by the Isle of Man's Lower Courts. Records in this collection include:

- minutes
- draft judgements
- criminal entry books
- criminal books
- criminal case files
- criminal indices

Administrative History: The Criminal Court in the Isle of Man is known as the Court of General Gaol Delivery. In its earlier days, it was held within the outer gates of Castle Rushen and was presided over by the Governor and attended by the Deemsters and Council and 24 Keys (Tynwald's membership).

An Act of 1737 - states *"That no Court, Judge, or Magistrate within the Isle whatsoever, shall have the power or authority for the future, to impose or inflict any fine or punishment upon a person or persons within the said Isle, for or on account of any Criminal Cause whatsoever"*

until he, she or they be first convicted by the verdict or presentment of four, six or more men, as the case shall require upon some Statute Law in force on the said Island...".

In essence, from this point onwards, serious Criminal causes or proceedings could no longer be dealt with in a Summary way by the Governor, Deemsters, Council and Keys which, at this point, constituted the Court. Therefore - in addition to the Court's existing membership - a jury of the respondent's peers had to be empanelled (with the number empanelled depending on the nature of the crime).

Tynwald members (Council and Keys) sat as part of the Court of General Gaol Delivery until 1820s when the Court became completely separate from Tynwald. From then on the Court was comprised of the Governor, the Clerk of the Rolls, the two Deemsters and a jury of twelve men. In 1921, the Governor was removed from the sitting panel of judges for the Court and responsibility for the Court of General Gaol delivery passed to the Second Deemster.

A number of Criminal Codes and laws relating to Criminal sentencing have impacted judgements handed down by the Court over time. While not intended to be exhaustive, these include:

- Criminal Law Act, 1981;
- Criminal Jurisdiction Act 1993;
- Criminal Justice Act 2001.

Custodial History: Records comprising this accession were created and held by the Court of General Gaol Delivery. The collection was then consigned to the Public Record Office under section 3(8) of the Public Records Act, 1999 between 2000-2012 . These consignments were - on assessment - transferred as full accessions under section 3(4) of the Public Records Act, 1999 in two discrete transfers in 2019 and 2020.
