## GDPR AND LED IMPLEMENTING (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2020

*Approved by Tynwald: 21 July 2020*  
*Coming into Operation: in accordance with Regulation 2*

The Council of Ministers makes the following Regulations under section 5 of the Data Protection Act 2018.

### 1 Title

These Regulations are the GDPR and LED Implementing (Amendment) Regulations 2020.

### 2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald, these Regulations come into operation on 4 August 2020.

### 3 GDPR and LED Implementing Regulations 2018 amended

In regulation 148 (application to Government) of the GDPR and LED Implementing Regulations 2018<sup>1</sup>, after paragraph (2) insert –

- (3) For the purposes of these Regulations, each of the following persons must be treated as an employee of the Lieutenant Governor when processing personal data in connection with the functions of the Lieutenant Governor –
  - (a) an officer of the Nationality Service of the Cabinet Office; and
  - (b) an officer of the Passport Service of the Cabinet Office. ■

*EXPLANATORY NOTE**(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations amend regulation 148 of the GDPR and LED Implementing Regulations 2018 so as to provide that officers of the Nationality Service and the Passport Service (in each case of the Cabinet Office) are to be treated as employees of the Lieutenant Governor when processing personal data in connection with the functions of the Lieutenant Governor for the purposes of those Regulations.
