SEA FISHING LICENSING (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2020

*Laid before Tynwald:**Coming into Operation:**1 April 2021*

The Department of Environment, Food and Agriculture makes the following Regulations under section 37 and 73(1)(b) of the Fisheries Act 2012 having —

- (a) consulted in accordance with section 83(2) and (5)(a) of that Act; and
- (b) satisfied itself that these regulations will not operate so as to contravene any instrument or agreement referred to in section 83(5)(b) of that Act.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Sea Fishing Licensing (Amendment) Regulations 2020.

2 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on 1 April 2021¹.

3 Interpretation

In these Regulations “**the principal Regulations**” means the Sea Fishing Licensing (No. 2) Regulations 2018².

4 Regulation 5 (applications for, duration and transfer of licences) amended

- (1) Regulation 5 (applications for, duration and transfer of licences) of the principal Regulations is amended as follows.

- (2) In paragraph (2)(b), for “31 March 2021” substitute ~~“31 March 2021”~~ “31 March 2022”.
- (3) In paragraph (4), for “£331” substitute ~~“£331”~~ “£338”.
- (4) In paragraph (6), for “£42” substitute ~~“£42”~~ “£43”.
- (5) In paragraph (7), for “£27” substitute ~~“£27”~~ “£28”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Sea Fishing Licensing (No. 2) Regulations 2018 [SD 2018/0336], the “principal Regulations”.

Accordingly, with effect from 1 April 2021, the principal Regulations are amended to prescribe —

- a fee of £338 for a sea fishing licence issued between 1 April 2021 and 31 March 2022;
- a fee of £43 for the issue of a replacement licence, which is required if there is any change to nominee details, ownership details, conditions of the sea fishing licence made at the licence-holders required, the vessel’s registration details or the vessel’s technical details; and
- a fee of £28 for the issues of a duplicate licence or replacement licence required for any reason other than the changes mentioned above.
