## HARBOUR (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) (AMENDMENT) BYE-LAWS 2022

*Approved by Tynwald: 21 June 2022*

*Coming into Operation: in accordance with byelaw 2*

The Department of Infrastructure makes the following Byelaws under section 4 of, and paragraph 14 of Schedule 1 to, of the Harbours Act 2010.

### 1 Title

These Byelaws are the Harbour (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Amendment) Bye-Laws 2022.

### 2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald, these Byelaws come into operation on the day after they are approved<sup>1</sup>.

### 3 Amendment of the Harbour (Miscellaneous Provisions) Bye-laws 2017

The Harbour (Miscellaneous Provisions) Bye-laws 2017<sup>2</sup> are amended as follows.
