## **REGISTRATION OF PLEASURE CRAFT (NO.2) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2022**

*Approved by Tynwald: 21 June 2022*  
*Coming into operation: in accordance with regulation 2*

The Department of Infrastructure makes the following Regulations under section 54 of the Harbours Act 2010.

### **1 Title**

These Regulations are the Registration of Pleasure Craft (No.2) (Amendment) Regulations 2022.

### **2 Commencement**

If approved by Tynwald, these Regulations come into operation on the day after they are approved<sup>1</sup>.

### **3 Amendment of the Registration of Pleasure Craft (No.2) Regulations 2017**

The Registration of Pleasure Craft (No.2) Regulations 2017<sup>2</sup> are amended as follows.


