



Landing and Taking Off Near Open-Air Assemblies

1. The Department for Enterprise ('the Department'), in exercise of its powers under Article 9 of the Civil Aviation (Rules of the Air) Order 2021¹, exempts any aircraft from the requirement to comply with Rule 3(2) of Schedule 1 to the Civil Aviation (Rules of the Air) Order 2021 ('The Rules of the Air 2021') subject to the condition in paragraph 2.
2. The condition specified in paragraph 1 is that the aircraft must not land or take off within 1,000 metres of an organised, open-air assembly of more than 1,000 persons except:
 - (a) at an aerodrome, in accordance with procedures notified by the CAA; or
 - (b) at a landing site which is not an aerodrome, in accordance with procedures notified by the CAA and with the written permission of the organiser of the assembly.
3. This permission has effect from **01 August 2021** until it is revoked.
