



Visual Meteorological Conditions (VMC) Visibility and Distance from Cloud Minima within Class G airspace by day

1. The Department for Enterprise ('the Department'), under paragraph SERA.5001 of Schedule 2 to the Civil Aviation (Rules of the Air) Order 2021¹ ('SERA'), permits flight visibilities reduced to not less than 1,500 m within Class G airspace by day for flights operating subject to the conditions set out in paragraph 2.
2. The conditions specified in paragraph 1 are that the aircraft is:
 - (a) flying at and below 900m (3,000 ft) above mean sea level, or 300m (1,000 ft) above terrain, whichever is the higher; and
 - (b) flying at speeds of 140 kt Indicated Airspeed (IAS) or less to give adequate opportunity to observe other traffic or any obstacles in time to avoid collision.
3. This General Permission has effect from **01 August 2021** until it is revoked.
