I have lived in the immediate area all my life-53 years.
Our family have a number of fields at Ballachurry,on the,bayr-ny-harrey,opposite the donkey track.
I personally,never remember the track ever being used at all.
It was never possible to walk very far-20 yards max, as there was sooo much growth of gorse and willows.
I do remember the occupants of Birds Croft-[REDACTED],,an immediate property near to the donkey track.
He would be gathering sticks & logs from the donkey track for the home fires but couldnt go far into the lane.
There may well be some folk,who are much older than myself,living locally,who may be able to assist with more local knowledge,but this is all I can recollect personally.
Surely,if this was a green lane,or footpath,why was it never maintained.
