I am emailing you re the public enquiry to be held into the designation of the u 72 [donkey track]

I was aware of the U 72 from discussions with various people.

The first time I walked the road was in early 2015.

I then carried out further visits to the track on the following dates in 2015 as recorded in my personal diary.

22 April 2015

I delivered my J C B 8027 digger to the road and proceeded to drive along the road clearing brambles and undergrowth.

This work was agreed between the department of infrastructure and Glug [green lane user group] [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] was present during the work.

4 May 2015

J C B 8027 used to clear brambles and thick vegetation up to the half way point in the road . [REDACTED]

and [REDACTED] road where there.

8th May 2015

I visited the site and walked the track with [REDACTED] and an officer of the department food and forestry to agree further work involving the removal of trees from the track .

17th May 2015.

A Sunday work party was organised to further clear the road up to the point at which the farmers access track crosses the road.

The work party reached the farmers crossing. I also walked the rest of the road.

Once these works were completed we then waited for the D O I to install a ditch crossing at the other end of the track,.
