

Donkey Track, Andreas - U 72

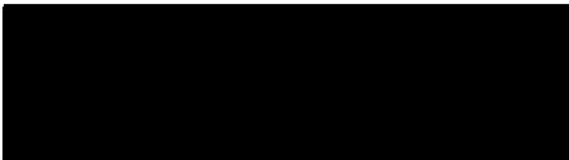
To whom it may concern
