CURRENCY ACT 1992: SPECIAL CURRENCY DETERMINATION

The Treasury makes the following Determination under section 6 of the Currency Act 1992.

CURRENCY (VIKING HERITAGE} (CROWN COIN} DETERMINATION NO. 7 2020

1. The Treasury determines that these coins known as a "Viking Heritage Collection Crown Coin Determination No. 7" may be issued to celebrate Viking Heritage in the Isle of Man.
2. A "Viking Heritage Crown coin" is any coin that -
 - (a) bears on the reverse the word "Crown" or (in the case of a coin which is denominated as more than one Crown) "Crowns"; and
 - (b) is issued under, and conforms to the requirements specified in, this Determination.
3. The permissible denominations of a Viking Heritage Crown coin are those shown in column 1 of the Schedule annexed to this Determination.
4. The face value of a Viking Heritage Crown coin of one Crown denomination is 5 pounds. The face value of a Viking Heritage Crown coin whose denomination is expressed as a fraction or a multiple of one Crown is 5 pounds divided or multiplied (as the case requires) by the fraction or the multiplier shown on the reverse of the coin.

Design of the Viking Heritage Crown coin

5. The obverse of a Viking Heritage Crown coin bears -
 - (a) the effigy of Her Majesty the Queen produced by Jody Clark for use on the coinage of the Crown Dependencies and the countries of the Commonwealth; and

- (b) the inscription "QUEEN ELIZABETH II • ISLE OF MAN" and the year of issue as shown in Figure 1:

6. The reverse of a Viking Heritage Crown coin depicts one of four additional designs in the Viking Heritage series.

Coin 1 - Features Harald Greycloak (ca. 935-976, the eldest son of Eric Bloodaxe) wearing his leather cape with his brothers and a Celtic cross from the Isle of Man as shown in Figure 2:

Coin 2 - Features Magnus the Good (son of Olav Haraldsson) as a child king on his throne, surrounded by other influential adults in his life as shown in Figure 3:

Coin 3 - Features Loki, the foster brother of Odin, surrounded by the Midgard Serpent, the wolf Fenrir and Hel. All of the three have prominent features at Ragnarok, as shown in figure 4:

Coin 4 - Features Hel, one of the children of Loki and a great monster in Norse mythology, she is shown on her throne, stroking a dog and with an image of her face, half human and half skeleton, as shown in Figure 5:

7. Each coin is circular with a milled edge.

Weight, composition, dimension and amount of tolerance and variation of the Viking Heritage Crown coins

8. The weight, composition and dimensions of the Viking Heritage Crown coins and the amount of tolerance allowed are specified in the table in the Schedule annexed to this Determination.
9. Despite any other provision of this Determination, a Viking Heritage Crown coin (of any permitted denomination) that otherwise conforms to the provisions specified in the table in the Schedule may be minted at double the weight shown in column 7 of the table as a *piedfort*, (except for coins already indicated as piedfort).

Saving

10. Nothing in this Determination affects the continuing validity of -
- (a) the Currency (Viking Heritage) Crown Determination 2017;
 - (b) the Currency (Viking Heritage) Crown No. 2 Determination 2017;
 - (c) the Currency (Viking Heritage) Crown No. 3 Determination 2018;
 - (d) the Currency (Viking Heritage) Crown Coin No. 4 Determination 2018;
 - (e) the Currency (Viking Heritage) £100 Coin No. 5 Determination 2019; and

- (f) the Currency (Viking Heritage) Cross Coin No. 6 Determination 2019.

The making of this Determination

10. This Determination comes into operation on the day after it is made.
11. This Determination is made by the Authority of the Minister for the Treasury.
