# Medicine, Urgent Care and Ambulance Service

- In the National Trainee Survey for IMT's the Isle of Man Secondary Health Care Directorate (i.e. Noble's Hospital) topped the rankings nationally.
- Consultant, SD and Nurse recruitment to vacant funded posts is ongoing and is seeing notable successes in some areas.
- Ambulatory Emergency Clinic established in MACU and Acute Oncology co-located with AEC to avoid admissions from ED and facilitate early discharges from the wards – pathways being further refined, GPs made aware and are referring directly.
- Head of Ambulance Service appointed, Lead ACP for MACU appointed—both start 10 January 2022.
- Frailty Lead ACP appointed.

# **Integrated Primary Care & Community Services**

- Therapies and Podiatry join our Care Group on 1<sup>st</sup> December.
- We hope to recruit to our Quality and Safety post w/c 27<sup>th</sup> November. This will help to build on the processes we currently have in place and offer assurance on clinical support within the primary care section of our care group
- Rebecca Dawson appointed as Dental and Optical Services Manager
- Primary Care at scale has appointed 2 clinical domain leads (1 session pw) for diabetes and muscular skeletal services.
   These 4 hour pw posts will support pathway design and governance. Further posts to support this work to follow.

## **Integrated Cancer and Diagnostics Services**

- The 'Clatterbridge @ Nobles' model is progressing well.
   Operational meetings continue presentation to Senior Managers between organisations planned for 02/12/21.
- Expressions of interest for the Band 7 Oncology Specialist Nurse are open.
- Recruitment of Cancer Manager, MDT Co-ordinators and Oncology Schedulers are underway.
- Specialist Advanced Practitioner posts job descriptions are being finalised, using Clatterbridge Cancer Centre models as a basis.
- Acute Oncology and Emergency Ambulatory Care team pilot for joint working continuing.
- In Radiology 1 General consultant has been offered a post after a successful interview. The Breast radiologist will be re-advertised.
- On-going Histopathology review with possibility of introduction of a Digital solution.
- JD for a second histopathologist prepared and submitted to RCPath.
- LIMS contract due to be signed.

### **Surgery, Theatres, Critical Care and Anaesthetics**

- Nicola Burgess recently qualified as an Endoscopist
- All 3 rooms in endoscopy will be utilised at the start of the New Year.
- Endoscopy Waiting List initiative began first week in November proving successful (96 points per weekend). This is done in-house and not with 18WS.
- Successful update of endoscopy software Solus.
- Nurse Endoscopist appointed and starting in November.

### **Integrated Social Care Services**

- Steering group to be established to develop a 'home first' strategy and approach
- Proposals now put forward to extend the Wellbeing hubs into the east of the Island
- Work has started on developing a Quality assurance framework for social care
- A reviewing task force has been set up to look at placements and care and support packages both on the Island and off
- Preparations are starting in anticipation of CQC inspecting ASC services in April 2022

## **Integrated Mental Health Services**
