



Quick Quote - Refurbishment and Modification of Plate Frame Coach Bogies

The Isle of Man Government invites quotations from suitably equipped and competent suppliers to provide to the Isle of Man Railways (IoMR), the services for the refurbishment and conversion of 'Plate Frame Bogies' for a number of our railway coach.

The bogies were originally built by Metropolitan Cammell circa 1880s through to 1930s. The original bogies were supplied in an un-braked design, but over the course of the supply contracts, the later bogies were supplied in a braked design.

The contract is to modify the earlier bogies to replicate the OEM design changes. At the same time, the original plain bearing axleboxes are to be modified to roller bearings and the bogies overhauled and renewed, correcting issues of general wear, age and degradation.

The total quantity of bogies involved is fourteen, of which ten are of the early un-braked variant and four are the later, braked variant. Due to the heritage of the equipment, few design drawings are available. Nonetheless details of the information available and full work scope are defined in a written specification.

The expectation is that the bogies are to be reworked at the rate of two to four bogies per year. IoMR will free issue the major components of wheelsets, axle boxes and springs where necessary. The bogies and free-issued parts will be shipped by IoMR as necessary.
