- Seeking to make an initial application for permission to stay under the Ukraine Family Scheme; or
- Seeking to make an application for permission to stay under the Ukraine Extension Scheme.

Application types

Appendix U: Ukraine Scheme sets out the requirements for permission to stay under the Ukraine Family Scheme & the Ukraine Extension Scheme. Any applicant must meet the criteria of the relevant section of Appendix U: Ukraine Scheme for the route that they apply under.

Ukraine Family Scheme

Where an eligible applicant is present in the Isle of Man and wishes to make an initial application for permission to stay under the Ukraine Family Scheme they must use this paper application form to do so.

Ukraine Extension Scheme

Where a applicant is in the Isle of Man and had; permission to enter or stay in the Isle of Man on 18 March 2022, they were in the Isle of Man with permission to enter or stay immediate before 1 January 2022 but that permission has since expired or they are a child born in the Isle of Man after 18 March 2022 they may use this application form to apply for permission to stay.
