GENERAL LICENCE

IOM/2022/SAN001

1. This licence is granted under all Autonomous Sanctions Regulations listed in Annex I of this licence.
2. Any act which would otherwise breach the prohibitions in the Autonomous Sanctions Regulations, as listed in Annex I of this licence, is exempt from those prohibitions to the extent required to give effect to the permissions in this licence.
3. In this licence —

"IOM Insurers" means	A firm with permission to effect or carry out contracts of insurance or reinsurance in the Isle of Man and registered by the Financial Services Authority (FSA).
The "DP" means	Those individuals or entities designated under the Autonomous Sanctions Regulations only, but not those sanctioned by the United Nations.
"the Autonomous Sanctions Regulations" means	Sanctions regulations, listed in Annex I of this licence and made under the Sanctions and Anti-Money Laundering Act 2018 (the Sanctions Act), as those Regulations have effect in the Isle of Man.
"Permitted Payments" means	Insurance premiums, reinsurance premiums and broker commissions relating to the provision of building and engineering insurance cover provided to Isle of Man or UK properties.
"Return Payments" means	Payments due as a result of a successful claim made against an insurance policy provided by the Isle of Man Insurers or refunds due as a result of over payments made pursuant to this licence.
"Buildings Insurance" means	Insurance covering the cost of repairing damage to the structure of a property.
"Engineering Insurance" means	Insurance against risks associated with erection, resting and working of any machinery, plant or equipment in commercial properties.

<p>"Relevant Institution" means</p>	<p>(a) a person who is licensed under the Financial Services Act 2008 (of Tynwald) to carry on a regulated activity within the meaning of section 3 of that Act;</p> <p>(b) a person who is authorised or registered under the Insurance Act 2008 (of Tynwald) or holds a permit under that Act;</p> <p>(c) a person who is registered under the Moneylenders Act 1991 (of Tynwald) to carry on the business of lending money;</p> <p>(d) a person who is acting as a trustee or an administrator of a retirement benefits scheme within the meaning of the Retirement Benefits Schemes Act 2008 (of Tynwald)</p>

Permissions

4. Under this licence, subject to the conditions in paragraphs 8-10 below:
 - 4.1. DPs may make Permitted Payments to IOM Insurers from a frozen Isle of Man or UK bank account; and
 - 4.2. IOM Insurers may receive the Permitted Payments.
5. Under this licence, subject to the conditions in Paragraphs 8-10 below:
 - 5.1. IOM Insurers may make Return Payments to frozen Isle of Man or UK bank accounts [for the payment of funds due as a result of a claim made pursuant to the Permitted Payments, or as a result of an overpayment]; and
 - 5.2. DPs may receive Return Payments from IOM Insurers into a frozen Isle of Man or UK bank account.
6. A Relevant Institution may process payments made in accordance with paragraphs 4 and 5 above.
7. This licence does not permit the provision of insurance to those also designated by the United Nations.

Reporting Requirements

8. Within 14 days of making a transaction under this General Licence, the DP must report to the FIU, with details and supporting evidence of:
 - i) The name of the IOM Insurer;
 - ii) The amount(s) transferred;
 - iii) The payment route used; and
 - iv) The date on which the funds were transferred.

9. Within 14 days of making a return payment under this General Licence, the IOM Insurers must report to the FIU, with details and supporting evidence of:
 - v) The amount(s) transferred;
 - vi) The payment route used; and
 - vii) The date on which the funds were transferred.


Record-keeping Requirements

10. The IOM Insurers and DPs must keep accurate, complete and readable records, on paper or electronically, of any activity purporting to have been permitted under this licence for a minimum of 6 years.

General

11. The permissions in this licence do not authorise any act which will result in funds or economic resources being made available in breach of the relevant autonomous sanctions Regulations, save as permitted under a licence granted under those Regulations.
12. Information provided to the Treasury or the FIU in connection with this licence shall be disclosed to third parties only in compliance with data protection legislation.
13. This licence takes effect from the date of issue and is of indefinite duration.
14. The Treasury may vary, revoke or suspend this licence at any time.
