



Expressions of Interest

Supply, Support and Maintenance of Rack Mounted and Desktop style Uninterruptible Power Supply Equipment

The Isle of Man Government invites expressions of interest from suitably capable and experienced suppliers to procure, install, support and maintain (both existing and new) rack mounted and desktop Uninterruptible Power Supply Equipment, to the Government Technology Services (GTS) of the Cabinet Office.

GTS provide an extensive range of information technology across over 250 buildings around the Isle of Man.

The services are utilised by:

- All Government Departments
- Government Statutory Bodies (but excluding IOM Post)
- Island Primary and Secondary Schools, and IOM College
- GP Surgeries.

There are a number of pieces of essential equipment that have power provision backed up by either rack mounted or desk top style Uninterruptible Power Supplies (UPS). This can be to provide continuous power to communications equipment or in some cases essential desktop PC's.

The service will encompass the supply, receipt, testing, installation and maintenance of new and existing UPS equipment required to maintain power to critical IT equipment including communications equipment and desktop PC's.

It is a mandatory requirement that the successful Contractor be accredited for the manufacturers' equipment set-out in the contract prior to entering into agreement and maintains such accreditations throughout the term. Bidders that are not currently accredited will be required to demonstrate their path to achieving compliance as part of their tender response.

In order to participate in this competitive exercise, your organisation must be registered on the Isle of Man Government's Procurement Portal. If you have not previously registered, please visit <https://in-tendhost.co.uk/iomg/asp/Home> and select 'Register' from the menu on the right side of the Home Page.

Once you have registered your organisation you should select this tender from the list of 'Current Tenders' and 'View Details' then click 'Express Interest' at the bottom of the page. Once you have clicked on 'Express an Interest' a 'Form of Acknowledgement' tab will appear. This tab will provide a copy of the 'Appeals Procedure' to be downloaded. In order to progress to the next stage of the process you will need to 'Opt-In' and complete the 'Form of Acknowledgment' questionnaire and click 'Submit Return' before the Expression of Interest deadline as detailed below.
