


Structure of the Isle of Man Health and Care System

The Chief Secretary within the **Cabinet Office** is tasked with implementing the recommendations

The **Health and Care Transformation Programme** work for the Chief Secretary to deliver the recommendations of the Final Report. The Programme leads a number of interlinked projects to achieve the defined transformation

Public Health provides advice and guidance across government to inform strategy and delivery of services. It promotes and co-ordinates the health and wellbeing across the Island to improve the quality of life and seek to reduce the demand on health and care services

DHSC required to deliver strategy, policy & legislation and to assure Manx Care's delivery. DHSC defines the services Manx Care delivers, to what standard and the financial envelope



The **Partnership Board** provides strategic support to DHSC and Manx Care in the identification, prioritisation and development of population health and wellbeing needs, services, outcomes required and funding implications

The **Treasury** provides funding and the associated financial scrutiny and guidance

Manx Care determines how to deliver the Mandated services, by itself or other contractors, to the required standard within the financial envelope
