

G. Summary of the evidence obtained in respect of Part 1 of the Investigation and some interim Conclusions

49. (1) There is a clear distinction between RSE delivery and drop-down day delivery.

(2) The [REDACTED] who gave the presentation on [REDACTED] was not delivering RSE but was delivering Inclusion. They were the same [REDACTED] who had given the presentation at QEII in 2021. They had also given presentations at other secondary schools on the Island. Previous presentations were without incident and do not appear to have attracted any external comment.

(3) Although this [REDACTED] " outside of their work for [REDACTED], they were not dressed in drag on the day in question and they never do so at work. Their casual appearance was confirmed by the teacher observers who were present. Apart from a reference to their Drag [REDACTED] [REDACTED] no mention of drag was made during the presentation.

(4) The teacher observers present both consider that the presentation was measured and appropriate.
