CURRENCY ACT 1992: SPECIAL CURRENCY DETERMINATION

The Treasury makes the following Determination under section 6 of the Currency Act 1992.

SPECIAL CURRENCY (KING CHARLES CORONATION – PART ONE) (COIN) DETERMINATION 2023

1. The Treasury determines that a coin known as the "King Charles Coronation - Part One coin" may be issued in the Isle of Man.

Interpretation

- 2. In this Determination the "King Charles Coronation Part One coin" means a coin that is issued by the Treasury, which conforms to the requirements
 - (a) of denomination and face value;
 - (b) as to design and devices to be borne; and
 - (c) as to weight, composition, form, and dimension, and the amount of variation from those matters allowed,

as specified in this Determination and the Schedule annexed to this Determination.

Denomination and face value of the King Charles Coronation - Part One Coin

- 3. The permissible denominations of the King Charles Coronation Part One coin are those shown in Column 1 of the Schedule annexed to this Determination.
- 4. The face value of the King Charles Coronation Part One coin is Five Pounds (£5.00).
- 5. The face value of the King Charles Coronation Part One coin whose denomination is expressed as a fraction or a multiple of one King Charles Coronation Part One is 5 pounds divided or multiplied (as the case requires) by the fraction or the multiplier shown on the reverse of the coin.

Design and devices to be borne of the King Charles Coronation - Part One Coin

- 6. The obverse of the King Charles Coronation Part One coin shall bear
 - ((a) the effigy of His Majesty the King produced by Glyn Davies; and
 - (b) the inscription 'KING CHARLES III ISLE OF MAN' and the year of issue as shown in Figure 1.

7. Reverse

- (1) The reverse of the King Charles Coronation coin shall bear
 - (a) one of five designs, including a combination of a line of text from the first verse of the British National Anthem along with each of the King's Beasts; and
 - (b) the face value of the coin, as described in the following sub-paragraphs and as shown in figures 2 to 6.
- (2) The reverse of the King Charles Coronation coin 1 shall bear
 - (a) the inscription "God Save Our Gracious King";
 - (b) an image of the Falcon of the Plantagenets and the Yale of Beaufort; and
 - (c) the face value of the coin depicted by the inscription "50p",
 - as shown in figure 2.
- (3) The reverse of the King Charles Coronation coin 2 shall bear
 - (a) the inscription "Long Live Our Noble King";
 - (b) an image of the Red Dragon of Wales and the Black Bull of Clarence; and
 - (c) the face value of the coin depicted by the inscription "50p", as shown in figure 3.

- (4) The reverse of the King Charles Coronation coin 3 shall bear
 - (a) the inscription "God Save The King";
 - (b) an image of the Lion of England and the Unicorn of Scotland; and
 - (c) the face value of the coin depicted by the inscription "50p", as shown in figure 4.
- (5) The reverse of the King Charles Coronation coin 4 shall bear
 - (a) the inscription "Send Him Victorious, Happy and Glorious";
 - (b) an image of the White Horse of Hanover and the White Lion of Mortimer; and
 - (c) the face value of the coin depicted by the inscription "50p", as shown in figure 5.
- (6) The reverse of the King Charles Coronation coin 5 shall bear
 - (a) the inscription "Long to Reign Over Us God Save The King";
 - (b) an image of the Griffin of Edward III and the White Greyhound of Richmond; and
 - (c) the face value of the coin depicted by the inscription "50p", as shown in figure 6.

Weight, composition, form and dimensions of the King Charles Coronation - Part One coin and amount of variation from those matters allowed

- 9. The table in the Schedule annexed to this Determination specifies the weight, composition and dimensions of the King Charles Coronation Part One coin and the amount of tolerance allowed is specified in the table in the Schedule annexed to this Determination.
- 10. Despite any other provision of this Determination, the King Charles Coronation Part One coin (of any permitted denomination) that otherwise conforms to the provisions specified in the table in the Schedule annexed to this Determination, may be minted at double the weight shown in Column 6 of the table as a *piedfort*.

The making of this Determination

- 11. This Determination comes into operation on the day after it is made.
- 12. This Determination is made by the Authority of the Minister for the Treasury.
