Description of Coastal walk which travels from cliff tops to beaches – beaches are shingle and although the stones can be compacted, care still needs to be taken. Due to the nature of the environment there are steep ascents (descents – depending on direction of travel) with large boulders for steps and uneven ground, there are other areas with large stones to walk over and step down. Boardwalks and bridges are used to pass boggy areas but there will be standing water in some places. The cliff top paths are narrow and exposed.
