Introduction

The Quarterly Statistical Report draws data and indicators relating to the performance of the Isle of Man economy together from a range of sources across and outside the Isle of Man Government.

Prior to 2020, the need for such a report was met by the then Economic Affairs Division's Quarterly Economic and Statistical Report. Publication of that report was temporarily discontinued during the COVID-19 pandemic due to much of the material produced in the report being made available via the Government's Economic Recovery Group dashboard. As that source of data is now no longer in operation, and in response to requests from members of the public and the Isle of Man Government, Statistics Isle of Man has made the decision to launch the Quarterly Statistical Report to perform a role similar to that of the Quarterly Economic and Statistical Report.

The Quarterly Statistical Report is currently under development. At present it borrows heavily from the Quarterly Economic and Statistical Report in structure and content. Statistics Isle of Man will be reviewing its content in order to enhance and improve the report's coverage and improve its usefulness to both Government and the public.

It was intended that this quarter's report would contain some provisional estimates from the population model currently under development by Statistics Isle of Man. However, due to the closeness to the publication for the main population report and a desire to further improve the data, such provisional estimates will instead start in next quarter's report.

Key Points

This report provides the latest available information as at 30 June 2023. Some of the key points from the report are as follows:

- The number of people in employment was 36,354, whilst that of those in selfemployment was 7,993.
- Inflation for the 12 months to June 2023 was 6.9% as measured by the Consumer Price Index (CPI). This is the lowest rate of inflation seen since March 2022.
- The number of people registered as unemployed was 228, which is the lowest number of unemployed people reported since 2002.
- There were 461 full time job vacancies and 327 part time job vacancies available at the end of June 2023. Overall these figures are lower than both the previous quarter and at the same time last year.
- The average house price at the end of June 2023 was £392,409, which is slightly higher than the March 2023 average of £386,318, and 4.8% higher than the same time last year.
- 389 new work permits and 88 renewals were issued in the three months to June 2023. It should be noted however that work permits will be impacted when exemptions to certain jobs or sectors are applied or removed. 184 new national insurance numbers were issued to foreign nationals, which includes anyone outside of the United Kingdom.
- There was a total of 795 ships registered on the Isle of Man with a total registered tonnage of 12.1 million tonnes. There are 5 less ships registered than at the end of June 2022.
- The total deposit base was £41.04bn as at 31 March 2023, which is the latest available data, and this is down from £41.40bn at the end of December 2022.
- Funds under Management amounted to \$13.12bn as at 31 March 2023, which is the latest available data, and this is down from \$13.25bn at the end of December 2022.




Oil Price - Brent Crude Oil Price (\$ per barrel)




World Economy








Bank of England Base Rate Projection

The employment estimate is based on the latest Income Tax records.




Inflation as at June 2023 stands at 6.9% for CPI and 9.5% for RPI.

Isle of Man Property Market – Prices compared to 12 months ago



For the 12 months to June 2023, the average house price was \pounds 392,409, a flat was \pounds 195,803 and the weighted property price was \pounds 349,490. The weighted property price is a weight average of house and flat prices based on transaction volumes.






For the 12 months to June 2023, 1,161 houses and 310 flats were sold.

All property market data is based on the latest available data from the Land Registry. There is a time lag in transactions being registered with the Land Registry, which is reflected by the difference shown between the first estimate, which is taken at the end of the applicable quarter and the later estimates which include transactions which were not lodged until after the first estimate was produced. Data is revised for up to 12 months after the first estimate has been published, after which point the data is considered final.



For the three months to June 2023 there were 307 Planning Approvals. There were also 289 Building Control applications received.


12 Month Rolling Average Electricity Consumption (Units Consumed '000s)

Benefits and Financial Support




In June 2023, 2,409 people claimed Income Support, 562 people claimed Short Term Incapacity benefit, 1,631 people claimed Long Term Incapacity benefit and 955 people claimed Employed Person's Allowance.

The number of people claiming all benefit types has decreased compared to March 2023. The reporting of these figures has changed slightly and now show the number of individuals who have been paid a particular benefit during the calendar month.



Registered Tonnage




As at June 2023, there were 795 ships registered on the Isle of Man, and the registered tonnage during the quarter to the end of June 2023 was 12.1 million tonnes.










Size of the Labour Market





Unemployment




As at June 2023, 228 individuals were registered unemployed, which is 63 less than in March 2023, and 57 less than at the same time last year. There are 23 individuals who have been unemployed for 12 months or more, and the 12 month average number of unemployed people is 285.



Quarterly Changes in Employment by Sector




Annual Changes in Employment by Sector for Seasonal Industries






Job Vacancies





Funds under Management (\$ Billion)



The total funds under management as at March 2023 is \$13.12 billion.






New Company Formation

During the quarter to June 2023, 224 1931 Act companies were formed, 139 2006 Act Companies were formed and 8 companies converted to 2006 Act Companies.


