# **APPLICATIONS, DECISIONS AND NOTICES**

The Road Transport Act 2001 ("the Act") and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee ("the RTLC") to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

#### **OBJECTIONS**

The Act provides for the RTLC to consider objections to applications in certain circumstances. Any person considering submitting an objection should first read the "Note on the submission by members of the public of objections to applications made to the RTLC" ("the Note") which is published in the "Downloadable Documents" section on front page of the RTLC website <a href="here">here</a>.

The Note sets out the procedure for submitting an objection, including the circumstances in which the RTLC is able to consider objections. Please be aware that the RTLC has no power to consider objections outside of the circumstances outlined in the Note.

#### **RTLC OFFICE**

The RTLC office operates on an appointment only basis. If you come to the office without an appointment you may have a wasted journey as there might not be anyone available to assist you.

### **APPLICATIONS**

#### 1. K Nalcaoglu – Variation of an Operator Registration

To vary the operator registration under Part "A" of the Register of Public Passenger Vehicles ("PPVs") through the addition of an operating centre. The applicant has applied to keep one PPV at Elm Tree House, Elm Tree Road, Onchan. An assurance from the Planning Section at the Department of Environment, Food and Agriculture ("Planning") may be required.

The registered address is identified in the application as 36 Nursery Avenue, Onchan.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Ply for Hire taxi in the South District.

Any potential objectors should refer to the "Objections" section on page 1 of this AD&N Circular for information on the correct procedure for making objections, including the circumstances in which the RTLC is able to consider objections.

#### 2. K Nalcaoglu – New Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence ("S29 Licence")

To apply for a S29 Licence, through the provision of one Ply for Hire taxi in the South District.

The registered address is identified in the application as 36 Nursery Avenue, Onchan.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Ply for Hire taxi in the South District.

#### 3. ME Shimmin – Variation of Operator Registration

To vary the operator registration under Part "A" of the Register through a change of registered address / operating centre.

The registered address / operating centre is identified in the application as Lower Ballachrink, Abbey Lane, Ballaragh Road, Laxey. An assurance from Planning may be required.

Any potential objectors should refer to the "Objections" section on page 1 of this AD&N Circular for information on the correct procedure for making objections, including the circumstances in which the RTLC is able to consider objections.

### **DECISIONS**

1. <u>Department of Infrastructure, t/a Bus Vannin ("Bus Vannin") – Application for a Variation of a Regular Service Licence ("RSL")</u>

RSL No. 02/08 - Services 1, 1A, 1H, 2, 2A, 11, 11A, 12, 12A, N1

A regular service of stage vehicles between;

- Willaston/Hailwood Avenue/Birch Hill and Port Erin/Port St Mary via the Airport & Castletown (11, 11A).
- Nobles Hospital/Hailwood Avenue and Port Erin/Port St Mary via the Airport & Castletown (1, 1A, 1H).
- Onchan, Ballachrink and Port Erin/Port St Mary via the Airport & Castletown (2, 2A).
- Douglas and Port Erin/Port St Mary (N1).

The service currently operates;

- On Mondays to Saturdays between the Promenades, Central Douglas and Port Erin at least every 20 minutes during the day, 30 minutes during the early evening and hourly during the later evening.
- On Sundays it operates every 20 minutes, with slightly reduced early morning and evening frequency.
- Night Owl (N1) journeys only operate on Friday and Saturday nights.

To operate the service by making the following amendments;

- A re-timing of daytime journeys.
- A partial renumbering of some services.
- The operation of an extra limited stop bus from Port St Mary/Port Erin to the Grandstand and the TT Course on TT Race Days (Service TT1)

Why are the variations required?

• Minor adjustments to journey times following the re-opening of Castle Street in Castletown and operational experience.

- Comments and confusion (especially in Lower Douglas) following the previous reduction in the amount of service numbers used.
- To provide a direct service on TT Race Days for residents and visitors from the South of the Island.
- There is no change to the general level of service provision.

#### The application was approved.

### 2. Bus Vannin – Application for a Variation of a RSL

RSL No. 02/13 – Services 5, 5A, 5C, 6, 6A, 6C, N5, and N6.

A regular service of stage vehicles between;

• Douglas and Ramsey via Crosby, St. John's, Peel, Kirk Michael and Ballaugh.

The service currently operates;

- Between Douglas and Peel approximately every 30 minutes during the day with alternate journeys providing an hourly service between Peel and Ramsey.
- Hourly between Douglas and Peel during the later evening with some journeys between Peel and Ramsey.
- Half hourly on Sundays between Douglas and Peel and every 2 hours between Peel and Ramsey during the day with infrequent journeys during the evening.
- Night Owl (N5) journeys only operate on Friday and Saturday nights.

To operate the service by making the following amendments;

- Operation of a schoolday Service 6C Ramsey to Douglas via QEII High School five minutes earlier between Ramsey and Peel.
- An evening journey from Peel to Douglas at 22:45 operating from Mondays to Thursdays only.
- A Fridays and Saturdays journey from Peel to Douglas operating as Service 6F via Foxdale and Glen Darragh Road.
- An extra Fridays and Saturdays journey from Ramsey to Douglas via Peel at 23:10.

Why are the variations required?

- The late arrival at QEII and Peel due to passenger numbers as well as traffic congestion.
- To provide a late journey to Foxdale on Fridays and Saturdays. On Fridays and Saturdays travel to Greeba and Crosby is available on the existing 23:15 departure from Peel.
- To provide a later departure from Ramsey to the Lezayre and west coast as well as a later journey from Peel to Douglas.

### The application was approved.

# 3. Bus Vannin – Application for a Variation of a RSL

RSL No. 02/09 – Services 22, 22H, 25, 25B and 25H.

A regular service of stage vehicles between;

• Nobles Hospital and Willaston/Birch Hill via Central Douglas & Bucks Road (22/22H) or via Victoria Road (25/25H).

• Schooldays journey between Central Douglas and Bemahague School via Victoria Road (25B).

To operate the service by making the following amendments;

- To operate a five minute advancement of the daytime provision.
- Slightly revised intermediate stop times.

Why is the variation required?

- To provide a more regular service to Bucks Road and Woodbourne Road (in connection with the Douglas to Ramsey service) and to avoid stand congestion at Lord Street.
- Operational experience and other road traffic.

### The application was approved.

#### 4. Bus Vannin – Application for a Variation of a RSL

RSL No. 02/10 – Services 44, 4B, 4R, 14, 14B, 8, 8R, N8.

A regular service of stage vehicles between;

- Douglas and Peel via Foxdale & Patrick (4, 4B).
- School day only journeys between Peel & Niarbyl and Braaid/Foxdale to Castletown (4, 14).
- Infrequent Monday to Friday journeys between Peel & Niarbyl and Douglas/Foxdale to Castletown (4, 14).
- Limited Mondays to Fridays journeys to Ballaughton Manor Hill and Cooil Road (14B).
- Infrequent Summer Saturday and Sunday service between Peel and Castletown or Peel and Port Erin (4R, 8, 8R).
- Approximate hourly Summer Saturday and Sunday service between Port Erin and The Sound (28).
- Occasional journeys between Peel and Port Erin via St Johns & Foxdale (N8).

To operate the service by making the following amendments;

- A change of provision of Mondays to Fridays social inclusion buses to Niarbyl and Ballamodha.
- The re-introduction of a Mondays to Fridays service to Groudle and Kind Edward Road on limited days only (Service 15) and transfer of these buses to this RSL.
- The re-introduction of a Mondays to Fridays service to Ballabrooie on limited days only (Service 15B).
- The re-introduction of a Summer Saturday and Sunday journeys to Niarbyl, Round Table,
   Peel to Castletown and Port Erin to Cregneash/Sound.

Why are the variations required?

- Better use of existing resources which also provides extra Douglas to Foxdale (& return) journeys.
- Public requests for a resumption of a social inclusion the Groudle/King Edward Road/ Ballabrooie journeys to only operate on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays in conjunction with a Tuesdays and Thursdays provision between Foxdale and Castletown.
- Customer and business requests and to cater for weekend leisure travel (local and visiting).

### The application was approved.

# 5. <u>Bus Vannin – Application for a Variation of a RSL</u>

RSL No. 02/19 - Services 3, 3A, 3B, N3, X3.

A regular service of stage vehicles between;

• Douglas and Ramsey via Laxey.

The service currently operates;

- Between Douglas and Ramsey via Laxey operating every 30 minutes Monday to Saturday daytime and hourly evenings and Sundays (3, 3A, X3).
- Night Owl (N3) journeys only operate on Friday and Saturday nights.

To operate the service by making the following amendments;

- A slight retiming between timetable points no change to overall times.
- A change of 08:00 Ramsey to Douglas journey from 3A to 3 (via St Ninians instead of Victoria Road).
- Additional Fridays and Saturdays journey at 2140 from Douglas to Ramsey.

Why are the variations required?

- Operational experience and other road traffic.
- To achieve the Douglas arrival time due to Victoria Road/Ballaquayle Road traffic congestion and a significant section of the passengers on this service wish to travel to Willaston (Grandstand stop).
- To provide an additional Fridays & Saturdays Douglas to Ramsey journey (in connection with 02/13 Ramsey to Douglas application) at a time currently not operated (21:40).

### The application was approved.

# 6. <u>Bus Vannin – Application for a Variation of a RSL</u>

RSL No. 02/47 - Service 29.

A regular service of stage vehicles between;

Douglas and Port Soderick via White Hoe on Schooldays only.

To operate the service by making the following amendments;

• To include the Douglas Town section within this service number.

Why is the variation required?

• To remove service number change currently applied mid journey (29 to 35 & vice versa).

### The application was approved.

### 7. ME Shimmin – New Operator Registration

To register as a new operator under Part "A" of the Register through the addition of the right to operate one Private Hire car.

The registered address and operating centre was identified in the application as The Flat, Kings Haven, Ballaragh Road, Laxey.

### The application was approved.

### 8. <u>KD Enchev – Variation of Operator Registration and S29 Licence</u>

To vary the operator registration under Part "A" of the Register through the addition of the right to operate one section 29 Ply for Hire vehicle of up to eight passenger seats in the Malew and South Districts.

The RTLC has received notification from the current Operator Registration of Premier Taxis of the intent to surrender part of that Registration's S29 Licence provided that the application is approved by the RTLC.

Should the application be successful, the applicant intended to combine his existing right to Ply for Hire in the East District with the right to Ply for Hire in the South and Malew Districts. This would have meant that the East, South and Malew Districts will all be included on the same Ply for Hire plate and the same vehicle being allowed to operate in all three Districts. There would have been be no overall increase in the number of service licences in use.

### The application was withdrawn.

# 9. SJ Leech – Variation of Operator Registration

To vary the operator registration under Part "A" of the Register through the addition of an operating centre.

The proposed operating centre was identified in the application as 15 Peveril Road, Peel.

#### The application was approved.

### 10. JG McConville – New S29 Licence

To apply for a S29 licence which would replace the existing licence on expiry, through the provision of one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

#### The application was approved.

#### 11. M Teare – New S29 Licence

To apply for a S29 licence which would replace the existing licence on expiry, through the provision of one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

### The application was approved.

#### 12. TW Kneen – New S29 Licence

To apply for a S29 licence which would replace the existing licence on expiry, through the provision of two Ply for Hire taxis in the East District.

#### The application was approved.

#### 13. S Osman – New S29 Licence

To apply for a S29 licence which would replace the existing licence on expiry, through the provision of one Ply for Hire taxi in the South and Malew Districts.

# The application was approved.

### 14. <u>P Storry – Variation of Operator Registration</u>

To vary the operator registration under Part "A" of the Register through a change of registered address and operating centre.

The new registered address was identified in the application as 26 Lhon Dhoo Close, Onchan.

The proposed operating centre was identified in the application as 25 Greeba Drive, Onchan and 11 Hillcroft, Douglas has been surrendered as an approved operating centre.

#### The application was approved.

### 15. SJ Leech – Variation of Operator Registration

To vary the operator registration under Part "A" of the Register through the addition of an operating centre.

The proposed operating centre was identified in the application as Flat 4, 1-3 Elm Drive, Onchan.

#### The application was approved.

#### 16. BL Wicklow – Variation of Operator Registration

To vary the operator registration under Part "A" of the Register through the addition of an operating centre.

The proposed operating centre was identified in the application as 7 Darragh Passage, Anagh Coar.

### The application was approved

#### 17. DJ McGee – New S29 Licence

To apply for a new S29 licence through the provision of one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

#### The application was approved.

#### 18. Adventureology Limited – New Operator Registration

To register as a new operator under Part "B" of the Register through the addition of the right to operate one Private Hire Minibus.

The registered address was identified in the application as 2A Water Street, Ramsey.

The proposed operating centre was identified in the application as Whispering Trees, Glen Road, Ballaugh.

### The application was approved.

### 19. JR Hanley – New Operator Registration and S29 Licence

To register as a new operator under Part "A" of the Register through the addition of the right to operate one section 29 Ply for Hire vehicle of up to eight passenger seats in the East District (wheelchair accessible).

The RTLC received notification from the current Operator Registration of PJ Langridge of the intent to surrender part of that Registration's S29 Licence provided that the application is approved by the RTLC.

Accordingly there will be no change to the number of Section 29 Ply for Hire vehicles in the East District that can be operated.

The registered address was identified in the application as 22 Robert Stephens Close, Douglas.

The proposed operating centre for the additional vehicle was identified in the application as 22 Robert Stephens Close, Douglas.

Any potential objectors should refer to the "Objections" section on page 1 of this AD&N Circular for information on the correct procedure for making objections, including the circumstances in which the RTLC is able to consider objections.

### The application was approved.

### 20. P Convery – New Operator Registration

To register as a new operator under Part "A" of the Register through the addition of the right to operate one Private Hire car.

The registered address / operating centre was identified in the application as 50 Faaie Ny Cabbal, Kirk Michael.

#### The application was approved.

### 21. <u>BL Wicklow – Variation of Operator Registration</u>

To vary the operator registration under Part "A" of the Register through the addition of a Private Hire minibus and an operating centre.

A new operating centre was identified in the application as 9 Cullyn Path, Anagh Coar.

### The application was approved.

### RTLC MEETINGS

The next regularly scheduled meetings of the RTLC for public passenger vehicles which will be held in public are currently due to take place on 25<sup>th</sup> May, 13<sup>th</sup> June and 27<sup>th</sup> June at Thie Slieau Whallian, Foxdale Road, St John's.

The applications listed in this AD&N are likely to be heard at one of these meetings as long as the RTLC has all of the information that it requires (e.g. assurances from Planning). All individuals that are required to attend a meeting will receive a formal invitation letter prior to the meeting.

If you intend to observe any meeting in public that you are not specifically invited to, it would be appreciated if you could inform RTLC staff of your intentions prior to the meeting. This information is required to ensure that there is sufficient space at the meeting to accommodate any observers. Should there not be sufficient space at Thie Slieau Whallian, a different venue for the meeting would have to be found and this could delay proceedings.
