The Road Transport Act 2001 and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee ("the Committee" or "the RTALC") to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

Within a period of twenty one days from the date of this publication, any person may write to the Committee making any objections or representations with respect to an application.

ROAD TRANSPORT (FEES) ORDER 2023

The above Order has now been approved by Tynwald. As a result, the following fee will be introduced, effective from 1st August 2023:

- Application for Goods Vehicle Operator Registration - £86

The fees below have been increased to the following amounts:

- Application for a Goods Vehicle Operator Licence - £86
- Variation of a Goods Vehicle Licence or Operator Registration - £35
- Goods Vehicle Operator Disc (including Trailer) - £60
- Replacement Goods Vehicle Operator Disc - £35

APPLICATIONS

1. Slade Scaffolding Limited – New Operator Registration

To register as a new operator through the addition of the right to operate three goods vehicles.

The operating centre is identified in the application as Plot 14c, Andreas Technical Site, Braust Road and the registered address is identified as 14 Albion Terrace, Ramsey.

The applicant has yet to obtain confirmation that its operating centre complies with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

2. Manx Agri Plant Services Ltd – Variation of an Operator Registration

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through the right to operate three additional trailers. There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The registered address of the Operator Registration is Ballachrink Farm, Ballanicholas, Braaid.

The applicant has yet to obtain confirmation that its operating centre complies with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

The applicant currently has approval to operate two goods vehicles.

3. A&B Metal Fabrications Ltd – New Operator Registration

To register as a new operator through the addition of the right to operate two goods vehicles.

The operating centre / registered address are identified in the application as Unit 16, Hills Meadow, Douglas.

The applicant has yet to obtain confirmation that its operating centre complies with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

4. Island Express Ltd – Variation of an Operator Registraton

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through a change in registered address and operating centre.

The new registered address / operating centre is identified in the application as Island Express Ltd, Peel Road Industrial Estate, Braddan.

Should the application be approved, the operating will surrender its existing operating centre at Unit 48E, Spring Valley Industrial Estate, Braddan.

The applicant has yet to obtain confirmation that its new operating centre complies with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

The applicant currently has approval to operate six goods vehicles and nine trailers.

5. Orrisdale Livestock Ltd – New Operator Registration

To register as a new operator through the addition of the right to operate two goods vehicles.

The operating centre / registered address is identified as Orrisdale Farm, Orrisdale Road, Ballasalla.

The applicant has already obtained confirmation that its operating centre complies with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

DECISIONS

1. Homefire Isle of Man Limited – New Operator Registration

To register as a new operator through the addition of the right to operate four goods vehicles.

The registered address / proposed operating centre was identified in the application as Balthane Industrial Estate, Ballasalla. The applicant already had planning approval for the operating centre. This Operator Registration has replaced the Registration for Castletown Fuels Limited which has been surrendered.

The application was approved.

2. MSN Roofing & Scaffolding Limited – Variation of an Operator Registration

To vary its Operator Registration through the addition of the right to operate two goods vehicles.

The application was approved.

3. J. Qualtrough & Co. Ltd – Variation of an Operator Registration

To vary its Operator Registration through the addition of the right to operate one goods vehicle and one trailer.

The application was approved.

4. Northern Fuels Ltd – Variation of an Operator Registration

To vary its Operator Registration through the addition of the right to operate two goods vehicles.

The application was approved.

5. Department of Infrastructure – Variation of an Operator Registration

To vary its Operator Registration through the addition of an operating centre and change of registered address.

The new operating centre was identified in the application as Turkeylands Quarry, Ballasalla. As an existing operator, the applicant has until 31st December 2023 to obtain confirmation that the operating centre complies with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

The new registered address is identified as 1st Floor, Sea Terminal, Douglas.

The application was approved.

COMMITTEE MEETINGS

The next regularly scheduled meetings of the RTAL for goods vehicles which will be held in public are currently due to take place on 24th October, 14th November and 23rd November at Thie Slieau Whallian, Foxdale Road, St John's.

All individuals that are required to attend a meeting will receive a formal invitation letter prior to the meeting. It is likely, although not guaranteed, that the applications advertised in this AD&N Circular will be heard at one of the November meetings provided that the RTAL has all the information that it needs (e.g. assurances from Planning).

Should you require information on the timetables for any upcoming meetings, please contact the RTLC office. If you intend to observe any meeting in public that you are not specifically invited to, it would be appreciated if you could inform RTLC staff of your intentions prior to the meeting. This information is required to ensure that there is sufficient space at the meeting to accommodate any observers. Should there not be sufficient space at Thie Slieau Whallian, a different venue for the meeting would have to be found and this could delay proceedings.
