



## GOODS VEHICLES APPLICATIONS, DECISIONS AND NOTICES

### Notice Period

The Road Transport Act 2001 and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee ("the Committee" or "the RTLC") to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

Within a period of twenty one days from the date of this publication, any person may write to the Committee making any objections or representations with respect to an application.

Written objections can be received by letter or email. They should include the name and address of the sender and include the reasons why the objection or representation is made. For the full procedure detailing the submission of objections please see the RTLC website.

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## NOTICES

### OPERATING CENTRES - TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1999 ("the 1999 Act") AND ROAD TRANSPORT REGULATIONS 2018

The RTLC reminds all existing operators that the period of grace to ensure that your operating centres comply with the above legislation expires on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2023.

It is therefore important to recognise that, from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024, if an operating centre does not comply with the 1999 Act, that operator will not be legally permitted to operate any goods vehicles with a maximum laden weight of over 3,500kg. To do so would be an offence.

### NEW RTLC INSPECTOR

You may have heard that a new RTLC Inspector has recently started. He is currently going through the process of visiting all of goods vehicle operators to introduce himself. Should he wish to visit your operating centres following these visits, he will contact you in advance so that a mutually agreeable time can be arranged. ## **APPLICATIONS**

1. Paul Carey & Sons Ltd – Variation of an Operator Registration

The applicant wishes to vary its Operator Registration through the addition of the right to operate three goods vehicles.

There are no new operating centres identified in the application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate nine goods vehicles and two trailers.

2. NK Construction Ltd – Variation of an Operator Registration

The applicant wishes to vary its Operator Registration through the addition of the right to operate one goods vehicle.

There are no new operating centres identified in the application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate three goods vehicles.

3. Taylor Specialist Transport Limited – New Operator Registration

The applicant wishes to register as a new operator through the addition of the right to operate one goods vehicle and one trailer.

The operating centre is identified in the application as Kella Farm, St Judes Road, Sulby and the registered address is identified as Halcyon Days, Main Road, Ballaugh.

The applicant has yet to obtain confirmation that its operating centre complies with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

## **COMMITTEE MEETINGS**

The next regularly scheduled meetings of the RTLC for goods vehicles which will be held in public are currently due to take place on 14<sup>th</sup> December, 23<sup>rd</sup> January and 27<sup>th</sup> February at Thie Slieau Whallian, Foxdale Road, St John's.

All individuals that are required to attend a meeting will receive a formal invitation letter prior to the meeting. It is likely, although not guaranteed, that the applications advertised in this AD&N Circular will be heard at one of the above meetings provided that the RTLC has all the information that it needs (e.g. assurances from Planning).

Should you require information on the timetables for any upcoming meetings, please contact the RTLC office. If you intend to observe any meeting in public that you are not specifically invited to, it would be appreciated if you could inform RTLC staff of your intentions prior to the meeting. This information is required to ensure that there is sufficient space at the meeting to accommodate any observers. Should there not be sufficient space at Thie Slieau Whallian, a different venue for the meeting would have to be found and this could delay proceedings.
