



GOODS VEHICLES APPLICATIONS, DECISIONS AND NOTICES

Notice Period

The Road Transport Act 2001 and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee ("the Committee" or "the RTALC") to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

Within a period of twenty one days from the date of this publication, any person may write to the Committee making any objections or representations with respect to an application.

Written objections can be received by letter or email. They should include the name and address of the sender and include the reasons why the objection or representation is made. For the full procedure detailing the submission of objections please see the RTALC website.

NOTICES

OPERATING CENTRES - TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1999 ("the 1999 Act") AND ROAD TRANSPORT REGULATIONS 2018

The RTALC reminds all existing operators that the period of grace to ensure that your operating centres comply with the above legislation expires on 31st December 2023.

It is therefore important to recognise that, from 1st January 2024, if an operating centre does not comply with the 1999 Act, that operator will not be legally permitted to operate any goods vehicles with a maximum laden weight of over 3,500kg. To do so would be an offence.

APPLICATIONS

1. Manx Utilities Authority – Variation of an Operator Licence

The applicant wishes to vary its Operator Registration through the addition of the right to operate 15 goods vehicles.

There are no new operating centres identified in the application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate 60 goods vehicles and two trailers.

2. Freight Hub Limited – New Operator Licence

The applicant wishes to apply for a new operator licence through the addition of the right to operate three goods vehicles and three trailers.

The registered address is identified in the application as 15 The Crescent, Douglas and the proposed operating centre is identified in the application as Land at the Clock Tower Industrial Estate, Foxdale.

The applicant has obtained a relevant certificate of professional competence but has yet to obtain confirmation that its operating centre complies with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

3. AV Craine & Sons Ltd – Variation of an Operator Registration

The applicant wishes to vary its Operator Registration through a change in registered address.

The new registered address is identified in the application as Unit 5, Tromode Estate, Tromode.

The applicant currently has approval to operate five goods vehicles.

4. Clean Tech Limited – New Operator Registration

The applicant wishes to apply for a new operator registration through the addition of the right to operate one goods vehicle.

The registered address and operating centre is identified in the application as Unit 5, Tromode Estate, Tromode.

The applicant has yet to obtain confirmation that its operating centre complies with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

5. Hesketh Investments Ltd – Variation of an Operator Registration

The applicant wishes to vary its Operator Registration through a change of operating centre.

The new operating centre is identified in the application as Units 2 & 3, Braddan Bridge Industrial Park. Should the application be successful, the operator will be surrendering Unit 1, Demesne Road, Douglas as an operating centre.

The applicant has obtained confirmation that the operating centre complies with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one goods vehicle.

DECISIONS

1. Manx Agri Plant Services Ltd – Variation of an Operator Registration

To vary its Operator Registration through the addition of the right to operate three trailers.

The application was approved.

2. Island Express Limited – Variation of an Operator Licence

To vary its Operator Licence through the change of registered address and operating centre.

The new operating centre was identified in the application as Island Express Limited, Peel Road Industrial Estate, Braddan.

The application was approved.

3. Ryan Cringle t/a RC Groundworks – New Operator Registration

To register as a new operator through the addition of the right to operate 10 goods vehicles.

The registered address / proposed operating centre was identified in the application as Unit 5, St. Andrews Works, Balthane Industrial Estate, Ballasalla.

The application was approved.

COMMITTEE MEETINGS

The next regularly scheduled meetings of the RTLC for goods vehicles which will be held in public are currently due to take place on 14th December, 23rd January and 27th February at Thie Slieau Whallian, Foxdale Road, St John's.

All individuals that are required to attend a meeting will receive a formal invitation letter prior to the meeting. It is likely, although not guaranteed, that the applications advertised in this AD&N Circular will be heard at either of the January or February meetings provided that the RTLC has all the information that it needs (e.g. assurances from Planning).

Should you require information on the timetables for any upcoming meetings, please contact the RTLC office. If you intend to observe any meeting in public that you are not specifically invited to, it would be appreciated if you could inform RTLC staff of your intentions prior to the meeting. This information is required to ensure that there is sufficient space at the meeting to accommodate any observers. Should there not be sufficient space at Thie Slieau Whallian, a different venue for the meeting would have to be found and this could delay proceedings.
