APPLICATIONS, DECISIONS AND NOTICES

The Road Transport Act 2001 ("the Act") and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee ("the RTLC") to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

OBJECTIONS

The Act provides for the RTLC to consider objections to applications in certain circumstances. Any person considering submitting an objection should first read the "Note on the submission by members of the public of objections to applications made to the RTLC" ("the Note") which is published in the "Downloadable Documents" section on front page of the [RTLC website](http://www.gov.im/rtlc).

The Note sets out the procedure for submitting an objection, including the circumstances in which the RTLC is able to consider objections. Please be aware that the RTLC has no power to consider objections outside of the circumstances outlined in the Note.

RTLC OFFICE

The RTLC office operates on an appointment only basis. If you come to the office without an appointment you may have a wasted journey as there might not be anyone available to assist you.

APPLICATIONS

1. J Townsend – New Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence ("S29 licence")

To apply for a S29 licence which would replace the existing licence on expiry, through the provision of one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

The registered address of the Operator Registration is 9 Fuschia Court, Douglas.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

Any potential objectors should refer to the "Objections" section on page 1 of this AD&N Circular for information on the correct procedure for making objections, including the circumstances in which the RTLC is able to consider objections.

2. MR Tacardon – New S29 Licence

To apply for a S29 licence which would replace the existing licence on expiry, through the provision of one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

The registered address of the Operator Registration is 31 Ballabrooie Grove, Douglas.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

Any potential objectors should refer to the "Objections" section on page 1 of this AD&N Circular for information on the correct procedure for making objections, including the circumstances in which the RTLC is able to consider objections.

3. MR Tacardon – Variation of Operator Registration and S29 Licence

To vary the Operator Registration and S29 licence of the applicant through the addition of the right to operate one section 29 Ply for Hire vehicle of up to eight passenger seats in the East District.

The RTLC has received notification from the current Operator Registration of DH Pugh of the intent to terminate that Registration's S29 licence provided that the application is approved by the RTLC. There will be no increase in the overall number of authorised Ply for Hire vehicles.

The proposed operating centre is identified in the application as 88 Cronk Grianagh, Strang. An assurance from the Planning Section at the Department of Environment, Food and Agriculture ("Planning") will not be required.

The registered address of the Operator Registration is 31 Ballabrooie Grove, Douglas.

The applicant currently has approval to operate Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

Any potential objectors should refer to the "Objections" section on page 1 of this AD&N Circular for information on the correct procedure for making objections, including the circumstances in which the RTLC is able to consider objections.

4. RN Boyde – Variation of Operator Registration and S29 Licence

To vary the Operator Registration and S29 licence of the applicant through the addition of the right to operate one section 29 Ply for Hire vehicle of up to eight passenger seats in the South and Malew Districts.

The RTLC has received notification from the current Operator Registration of RS Trimble of the intent to terminate that Registration's S29 licence provided that the application is approved by the RTLC.

The applicant would like to combine the new (to him) Malew District with his current East District that the applicant is currently permitted to operate onto one vehicle. The intention is to operate the South District on a separate Ply for Hire vehicle. There will be no overall increase in the number of service licences in use or authorised Ply for Hire vehicles.

The proposed operating centre is identified in the application as 8 Minorca Crescent, Laxey. An assurance Planning will not be required.

The registered address of the Operator Registration is 14 Auburn Road, Onchan.

The applicant currently has approval to operate Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

Any potential objectors should refer to the "Objections" section on page 1 of this AD&N Circular for information on the correct procedure for making objections, including the circumstances in which the RTLC is able to consider objections.

5. SM Campion, t/a Castle Cabs (2020) Limited – Variation of Operator Registration

To vary the Operator Registration of the applicant through a change of registered address / operating centre.

The new registered address / operating centre is identified in the application as 13 Cringle Close, Ballasalla. An assurance from Planning will not be required.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Ply for Hire taxi in the South and Malew Districts and one Private Hire car.

6. The Department of Infrastructure, t/a Bus Vannin ("Bus Vannin") – Variation of a Section 25 Regular Service Licence ("RSL")

RSL No. 02/09 – Services 22, 22H, 25, 25B and 25H.

A regular service of stage vehicles between;

- Nobles Hospital and Willaston/Birch Hill via Central Douglas & Bucks Road (22/22H) or via Victoria Road (25/25H).
- Schooldays journey between Central Douglas and Bemahague School via Victoria Road (25B).

To operate the service by making the following amendments;

- To operate the Mondays to Fridays 07:55 departure from Lord Street to Willaston at 07:45 to operate 10 minutes earlier until the return to Lord Street and to then depart Lord Street at 08:42 (no change) to Nobles Hospital (due at 08:52).

Why is the variation required?

- This journey is patronised by Nobles Hospital staff who start work at 09:00. Due to increasing traffic issues between 08:00 and 09:00 in the Douglas area, this journey frequently arrives at Lord Street after 08:50 for the journey to the Hospital therefore making the Hospital staff late for work.

The registered address of the operation is Transport Headquarters, Banks Circus, Douglas, IM1 5PT.

Bus Vannin currently has approval to operate 90 buses and 90 minibuses using 11 RSLs.

Any potential objectors should refer to the "Objections" section on page 1 of this AD&N Circular for information on the correct procedure for making objections, including the circumstances in which the RTLC is able to consider objections.

7. MG McGreal – New S29 Licence

To apply for a S29 licence which would replace the existing licence on expiry, through the provision of one Ply for Hire taxi in the South and Malew Districts.

The registered address of the Operator Registration is 27 Castle Court Apartments, Farrants Way, Castletown.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Ply for Hire taxi in the South and Malew Districts.

Any potential objectors should refer to the "Objections" section on page 1 of this AD&N Circular for information on the correct procedure for making objections, including the circumstances in which the RTLC is able to consider objections.

8. RG Teare – New Operator Registration

To register as a new operator under Part "A" of the Register of Public Passenger Vehicles ("PPVs") through the addition of the right to operate one Private Hire car.

The registered address / operating centre is identified in the application as 9 Bircham Avenue Close, Ramsey.

Any potential objectors should refer to the "Objections" section on page 1 of this AD&N Circular for information on the correct procedure for making objections, including the circumstances in which the RTALC is able to consider objections.

9. The Venture Centre – Variation of Operator Registration

To vary the operator registration of the applicant by moving from Part "B" of the Register of PPVs to Part "A".

To further vary the Operator Registration of the applicant through the addition of two Private Hire minibuses.

The registered address / operating centre is identified in the application as The Venture Centre, Jacks Lane, Maughold. An assurance from Planning may be required.

The applicant currently has approval to operate two Private Hire minibuses.

Any potential objectors should refer to the "Objections" section on page 1 of this AD&N Circular for information on the correct procedure for making objections, including the circumstances in which the RTALC is able to consider objections.

10. P Noble – Variation of Operator Registration

To vary the Operator Registration of the applicant through a change of registered name.

The new name of the operator registration is identified in the application as "P Cowley-Noble".

The registered address of the Operator Registration is 20 Fuchsia Lane, Douglas.

The applicant currently has approval to operate Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

Any potential objectors should refer to the "Objections" section on page 1 of this AD&N Circular for information on the correct procedure for making objections, including the circumstances in which the RTALC is able to consider objections.

CORRECTION

In AD&N Circular No. 558, the following application was advertised incorrectly. The right to Ply for Hire in the East District in addition to the South District was omitted. The correct application follows below:

11. Isle Drive Taxis Limited – New Operator Registration and S29 Licence

To register as a new operator under Part "A" of the Register of PPVs and apply for a new S29 licence through the addition of the right to operate one section 29 Ply for Hire vehicle of up to eight passenger seats in the South District and one section 29 Ply for Hire vehicle of up to eight passenger seats in the East District.

The RTLC has received notification from the current Operator Registration of K Nalcaoglu of the intent to terminate that Registration's S29 licence provided that the application is approved by the RTLC. There will be no increase in the number of authorised Ply for Hire vehicles.

The registered address is identified in the application as 33 Main Road, Onchan.

There are two new operating centres identified in the application;

- 36 Nursery Avenue, Onchan (already an approved operating centre) and
- Elm Tree House, Main Road, Onchan (an assurance from Planning may be required).

Any potential objectors should refer to the "Objections" section on page 1 of this AD&N Circular for information on the correct procedure for making objections, including the circumstances in which the RTLC is able to consider objections.

DECISIONS

1. S Hesketh, t/a Ronaldsway Taxi Services – Variation of Operator Registration and S29 Licence

To vary the Operator Registration and S29 licence of the applicant through the addition of the right to operate one section 29 Ply for Hire vehicle of up to eight passenger seats in the East District.

The RTLC received notification from the current Operator Registration of BS Hesketh of the intent to terminate that Registration's S29 licence provided that the application is approved by the RTLC.

The applicant wanted to combine the East District with the South and Malew Districts that the applicant was currently permitted to operate onto one vehicle.

This meant that the South, East and Malew Districts would all be included on the same Ply for Hire plate and the same vehicle allowed to operate in all Districts. There was no overall increase in the number of service licences in use as a result.

No additional operating centres were identified in the application.

The registered address was identified in the application as 39 Howe Road, Onchan.

The application was approved.

2. DJ Chatel – New S29 Licence

To apply for a new S29 Licence, through the provision of one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

The registered address was identified in the application as 1 Eleanora Gardens, Douglas.

The application was approved.

3. MJ Bell – Variation of Operator Registration

To vary his Operator Registration under Part "A" of the Register through a change to the registration's current operating centre. The applicant applied for permission to keep two PPVs at his current operating centre of 19 Ballachrink, Colby. Previously, this operating centre had only been approved for one PPV.

The registered address / operating centre was identified in the application as 19 Ballachrink, Colby. An assurance from Planning was received.

The application was approved.

4. MW Hegarty – New Operator Registration

To register as a new operator under Part "A" of the Register of PPVs through the addition of the right to operate one Private Hire car.

The registered address / operating centre was identified in the application as 20 Ballakermeen Road, Douglas.

The application was approved.

5. SA Stringer – New Operator Registration and S29 Licence

To register as a new operator under Part "B" of the Register of PPVs and apply for a new S29 licence through the addition of the right to operate one section 29 Ply for Hire vehicle of up to eight passenger seats in the South and Malew Districts.

The RTLC received notification from the current Operator Registration of PJ Brearley of the intent to terminate that Registration's S29 licence provided that the application is approved by the RTLC.

The registered address / operating centre was identified in the application as Heatherlea, Bay View Road, Port Erin.

The application was approved.

6. Happy Days Nursery Limited – New Operator Registration

To as a new operator under Part "A" of the Register of PPVs through the addition of the right to operate one Private Hire minibus.

The registered address / operating centre was identified in the application as 4 Cringle Close, Reayrt Mie, Ballasalla.

The application was approved.

RTLC MEETINGS

The next regularly scheduled meetings of the RTLC for public passenger vehicles which will be held in public are currently due to take place on 24th October, 14th November and 23rd November at Thie Slieau Whallian, Foxdale Road, St John's.

The applications listed in this AD&N are likely to be heard at one of the November meetings as long as the RTLC has all of the information that it requires (e.g. assurances from Planning). All individuals that are required to attend a meeting will receive a formal invitation letter prior to the meeting.

Should you require information on the timetables for any upcoming meetings, please contact the RTLC office. If you intend to observe any meeting in public that you are not specifically invited to, it would be appreciated if you could inform RTLC staff of your intentions prior to the meeting. This information is required to ensure that there is sufficient space at the meeting to accommodate any observers. Should there not be sufficient space at Thie Slieau Whallian, a different venue for the meeting would have to be found and this could delay proceedings.
