Interpretation Act 2015

HARBOUR (FEES) ORDER 2024

Laid before Tynwald: 19 March 2024

Coming into Operation in accordance with Article 2

The Department of Infrastructure, with the concurrence of Treasury,¹ makes the following Order² under section 81 of the Interpretation Act 2015.

1 Title

This Order is the Harbour (Fees) Order 2024.

2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation on the day after it is laid before Tynwald.

3 Harbour fees

- (1) In respect of each function or service specified in column 2 of the Schedule, the fee specified in column 3 is payable by any person benefiting from the function or using the service, as the case may be.
- (2) Paragraph (1) is subject to article 4.

4 Exemption

- (1) Article 3 does not apply to officers of the Customs and Excise Division of the Treasury.
- (2) For the purpose of this article, “officer” has the same meaning as section 184 of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1986.

5 Revocation

The Harbour (Fees) Order 2023³ is revoked.
