NATIONALITY (FEES) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2024

Laid before Tynwald: Coming into Operation

6 April 2024

The Governor, with the consent of the Treasury, makes the following Order under section 68(1) to (6), (12) and (13), and section 69(1) of the Immigration Act 2014 (of Parliament)¹ as that Act has effect in the Island².

1 Title

This Order is the Nationality (Fees) (Amendment) Order 2024.

2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation on 6 April 2024³.

3 Amendment of the Nationality (Fees) Order 2020

- (1) The Nationality (Fees) Order 2020⁴ is amended as follows.
- (2) In article 5 (nationality), in Table 1 in the 3rd column (maximum amount) of -
 - (a) row 6.3, for "£250" substitute $\mathfrak{L}400\mathfrak{D}$;
 - (b) row 6.4, for "£100" substitute $\mathfrak{L}150\mathfrak{D}$;
 - (c) row 6.6, for "£250" substitute $\mathbf{\Xi}$ £400 $\mathbf{\Sigma}$; and
 - (d) row 6.7, for "£250" substitute \mathfrak{G} £400 \mathfrak{D} .

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the Nationality (Fees) Order 2020 (SD No. 2020/0073) to increase the maximum amounts that can be charged for the following services connected with nationality:

- amendment of a certificate of registration or naturalisation as a British citizen;
- arrangement of a citizenship ceremony;
- certified copies of certain notices, certificates, orders, declarations or entries; and
- copies, replacements, or amended versions of certain documents.

This Order maintains the Island's alignment with the UK in matters relating to nationality fees.
