



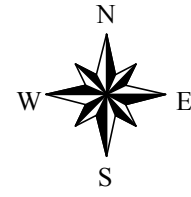
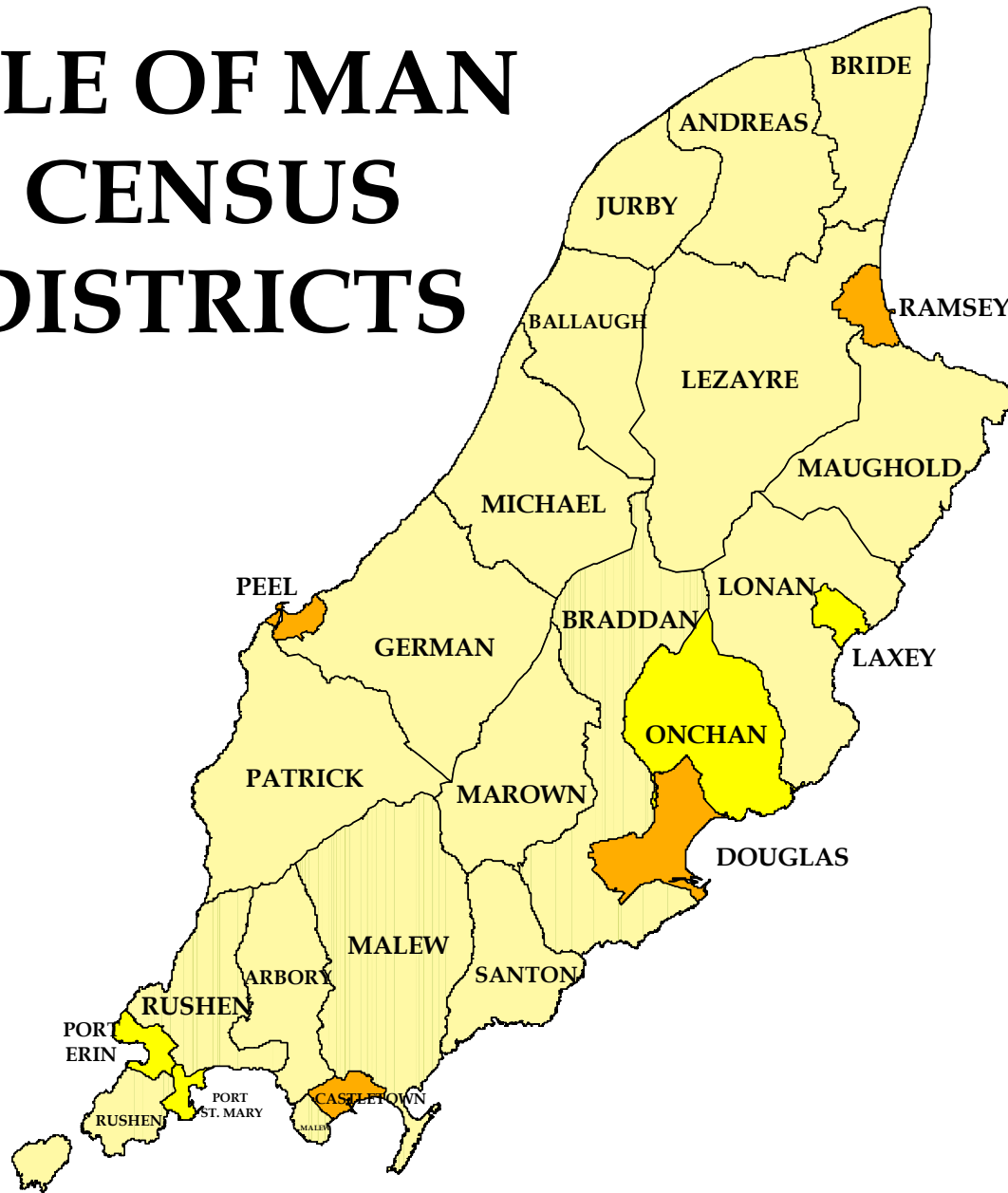

INTRODUCTION

This report contains information gathered in the 2001 Isle of Man Census held on 29th/30th April 2001. It is the most recent in a series dating back to 1821. A full census is held every ten years and is a comprehensive survey of the people and households in the Island.

The 2001 Census was conducted by the Economic Affairs Division of the Treasury under the authority of the Census Act 1929.

The 2001 Census requested more information than previous censuses. In particular, there were additional questions on qualifications, long-term illness and carers whilst, to facilitate further analysis, questions were asked on the relationship between all members of a household rather than only the relationship to the head of the household.

This report covers the information that is most frequently sought by users. A further report is available including more in-depth analysis. This report is available via the Internet on the Economic Affairs Division website which is located at www.gov.im/census.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- The Isle of Man resident population in the 2001 Census was 76,315. This represents an increase in the resident population of 4,601 (6.4%) since the Interim Census in 1996. It also represents an increase of 6,527 (9.4%) since the last full Census was undertaken in 1991.
- The Isle of Man Census population including visitors to the Island as well as residents was 78,266 and this is an increase of 3,586 (4.8%) from 1996.
- The broad age structure of the population has changed since 1996 as follows:

- The dependency ratio (the number of children and individuals of retirement age as a percentage of those of working age) has fallen from 68.3% in 1991, to 65.7% in 1996, and to 62.1% in 2001.

- Douglas accounts for over one third of the Island's resident population and over 32% of Island households.

- The number of residents born on the Isle of Man is now 48.0% of the resident population.
- The economically active population increased again from 34,811 in 1996 to 39,685 with a record number in employment of 39,050.
