EXPLANATORY NOTES

This notice must be published and circulated in a newspaper on the Island not later than 10 days before the fireworks are to be let off.

The recommended size for the Public Notice is 6 cm x 2 col (5.8 cm) which will cost approx £50.00 at Isle of Man Newspapers.

The precise location of where the firework(s) will be let off must be stated in the notice.

The notice is only valid for the date stated on it. If due to inclement weather the event is postponed then it may be held on the second date notified for that purpose.

If you are holding a public display you are invited to include such wording as you require along the lines of 'all are warmly welcomed'.
