JOINT DECLARATION

BY THE ISLE OF MAN AND THE PORTUGUESE REPUBLIC

Following today's signing of an Agreement for the Exchange of Information relating

to Tax Matters, negotiations will continue between the Isle of Man and Portugal on

measures to alleviate undesired tax barriers and other obstacles of a discriminatory

nature that may be included in the domestic tax legislation of the Parties. In

particular, it is the intention of the Parties to conclude an agreement for the

allocation of taxing rights in respect of certain income of individuals and to establish

a mutual agreement procedure in connection with the adjustment of profits of

associated enterprises as soon as possible after today's agreement enters into

force. In due course, it is the intention of the Parties to integrate such an

agreement and the agreement signed today into a comprehensive double taxation

agreement.
